Another reminder, children under the age of eleven need to be accompanied at MCPL at all times. Often times children will walk to visit us on Snow Days and we want to keep them safe.

If your child is eleven or older and plans to visit us alone please make sure they are warmly dressed and have a planned ride. Library staff members are legally unable to transport any library patron (adult or child) via vehicle.

In the case of an emergency closing and/or a child being left unattended after business hours the staff on duty will wait for fifteen minutes while we attempt to contact a parent or guardian (children are also prompted to utilize our phones to try and reach a parent or guardian prior to closing).

In the case that we are unable to contact a parent or guardian the Lebanon Police will be contacted and the child will be discharged into their care until the time that they can reach the parent or guardian.

Please keep safe and remember that slick roads and cold temperatures can be very dangerous.
