I direct that at my death my executor do sell at public sale the tract of land on which I now live containing one hundred and ninety five acres on a credit of one and one half years, etc. And transferring to the purchaser all of my reports upon the Josiah Wilson heirs of whom I purchased in his the said Josiah's life time and from whom I received the deed.

Secondly I direct that all of my negross of which I possess by sold by my executors by public sale on a credit of one year, etc.

Three I direct that all of my live stock, household and kitchen furniture farming utensils be sold by my executors on a twelve months credit, etc.

Four I direct the proceeds of the sale of all of my things be divided between all of my legal heirs that is to say the children, the heirs of my deceased daughter Elizabeth Hardin once wife of Benone Hardin who may be living at the time of my death one fifth part. The children and heirs of my deceased son William Askren who may be living at the time of my death one fifth part. My daughter Mary Askren wife of Josiah Askren if she should survive me at the time of my death if not her children one fifth part. The children of my deceased daughter Martha Cummins that may be living at the time of my death one fifth part. And the children of my deceased daughter Sarah Gillihan that may be living at the time of my death one fifth part.

Now I add this condition to the above distribution I gave to my children as they married and left me property to the following amount: Viz: To Elizabeth Hardin one hundred and three dollars, to William Askren ninety seven dollars, To Mary Askren eighty eight dollars, To Martha Cummins seventy eight dollars, To Sarah Gillihan ninety three dollars and I also hold on Mathew Cummins two notes for cash advance during the life time of his wife Martha one for forty dollars dated July 13, 1819 and one dated October 20, 1828 and one note on Mark Gillihan for thirteen dollars dated August 7, 1830. The above notes to be deducted from my children's parts. And my daughter Mary Askren in the proposition received by her, etc.

I hereby appoint my son in law Josiah Askren executor to this my last will, etc.
