## BEARD

Josiah Beard was born Feb. 14, 1790, in Shelby County, Tennessee and was brought to Kentucky when he was eight.

Josiah Beard's father, Samuel Beard, took his family first to Crab Orchard, Lincoln County, and after a brief stay went to Carpenter's Station in the same county. Later Samuel settled on a large farm on Green River, two and a half miles below the mouth of Casey Creek, then in Green, now Adair County. Here he induced a number of friends to settle by giving them land.

Samuel Beard had the first grist-mill in Adair County which was then Green County. It was on Green River, 2 1/2 miles below the mouth of Casey Creek.

Josiah Beard, the son of Samuel Beard, married Demia Mann the daughter of Moses and Frances Bland Mann, on November 3, 1814. Josiah and Demia later lived on a farm near Mannsville, the farm was given to them by Moses Mann, Demia's father. They lived there until 1836, when they moved to Columbia, Adair County. In 1856 they made their home with their son, James W. and this is where they died - Josiah on Feb. 25, 1866 and Demia, on May 9, 1882. According to the year dates, Demia had been born on October 14, 1792, and had lived to be nearly one hundred years old but then her father, Moses Mann, had lived to be ninety-seven..

Josiah Beard had fared well by his father-in-law, Moses Mann.. In Mann's will he had divided the proceeds of the salt manufacturing in Mannsville between his daughter's husband, Josiah Beard, and his own son, John Mann. He also willed Josiah Beard two slaves, Jack and Levin.

Dr. John Josiah Beard and his wife Mary N. were the parents of (a) Frances Beard who married John D. Foyle, and (b) Anna Beard who married Selden Hatcher and (c) Dr. J. C. Beard who married Lou Gay. This is the Doctor Beard that practiced medicine in Bradfordsville, Kentucky. He is also supposed to have resided for a time in Rowlett in

Robert, (According to Eula Rae Kirtland in 1997 while documenting the grave dates in Old Liberty Cemetery near Bradfordsville, Ky., she located the grave of Robert Beard's wife marked Eulin born in 1831 and died in 1902. Kirtland noted that Eulin and Robert Beard are parents of a son buried nearby who was born in 1849 and died in 1901. Another son of a Robert Beard is buried nearby. This son is named Willy born in 1868 and died in 1879 and his mother is given as H.D. Beard. Kirkland speculates that Robert Beard was married twice but there is also a possibility there were two Robert Beards who have sons buried close together. Further research is needed.)

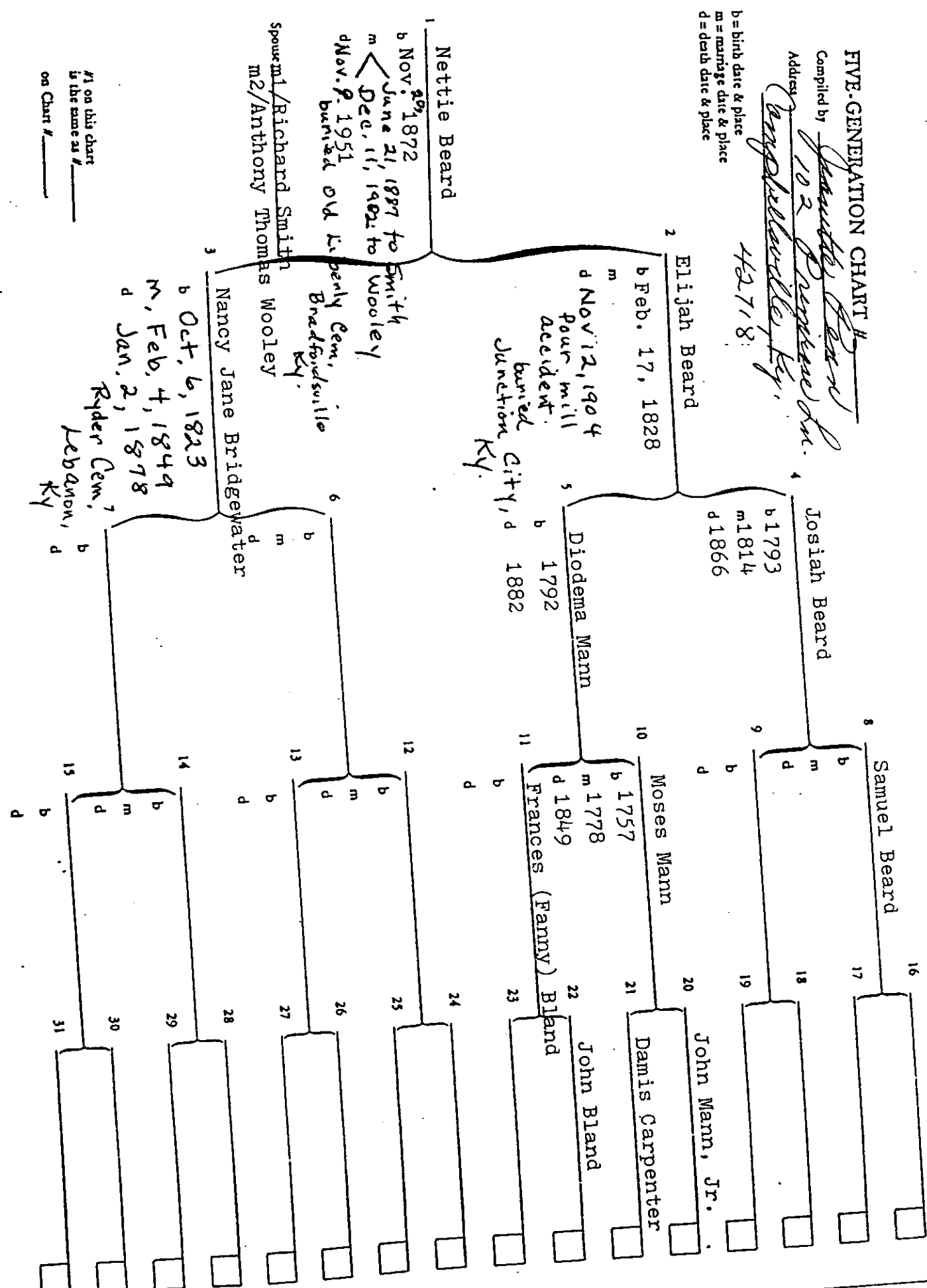

Gennetta "Nettie" Beard was the youngest of Elijah and Nancy Jane Beard's children. Nettie was only four years old when her mother, Nancy Jane, died. She was eleven when her father married again. Perhaps losing her mother at such a tender age and the difficulty of accepting a step-mother had a bearing on Nettie accepting Richard Smith's proposal of marriage when she was only fourteen.

She and Richard had four children: Othie (a son), Johnny, Maggie, and Arthur. Nettie's husband, Richard Smith, died in October, 1896. Four months later, in February, 1897, her seventeen-month-old baby Arthur "Otta" died. Father and son are buried in Merrimac Cemetery, Taylor County.

She was only twenty-five years old when left widowed with three children; the oldest around eight years of age and the youngest, Maggie, being four.

December 11, 1902, she married bachelor, Anthony "Tom" Wooley. Her oldest son, Othie, did not like Tom Wooley so he left home and went to Kansas. He stayed, married, and made his home there. He only returned once for a visit.

Nettie and Tom Wooley had four sons: Henry, Joe, Charles, and Ernest. Tom Wooley and his sons worked closely with Tom's brother, Ben Wooley, who was a prosperous stave mill operator and farmer in Marion County. Ben Wooley urged his two oldest nephews, Henry and Joe, to find employment in Lebanon. Henry and Joe followed his advice but Henry was unhappy and returned to the farm to be with his family. Joe stayed on with the garage work in Lebanon, and later moved to Louisville, and later to Oak Ridge, Tennessee.

Tom and his boys bought the "Tom Wooley" farm from off the "Ben Wooley" place. Later Ben Wooley's place with its stately home passed into his nephew's hands, Dr. Vaughn, who resided in Louisville. In the '50's Don V. Drye, Sr. brought the farm from the Vaughn heirs. Drye modernized the house and made aesthetic improvements to its surroundings.

Tom Wooley died July 10, 1935. Nettie continued on living in the big house sharing it with Henry and his family. Charles made improvements to another house on the farm and reared his family there. Ernest built his home adjacent to the farm. Having established their homes close together the three Wooley Brothers worked this family farm, cared for their mother, and became respected farmers and citizens in their community.

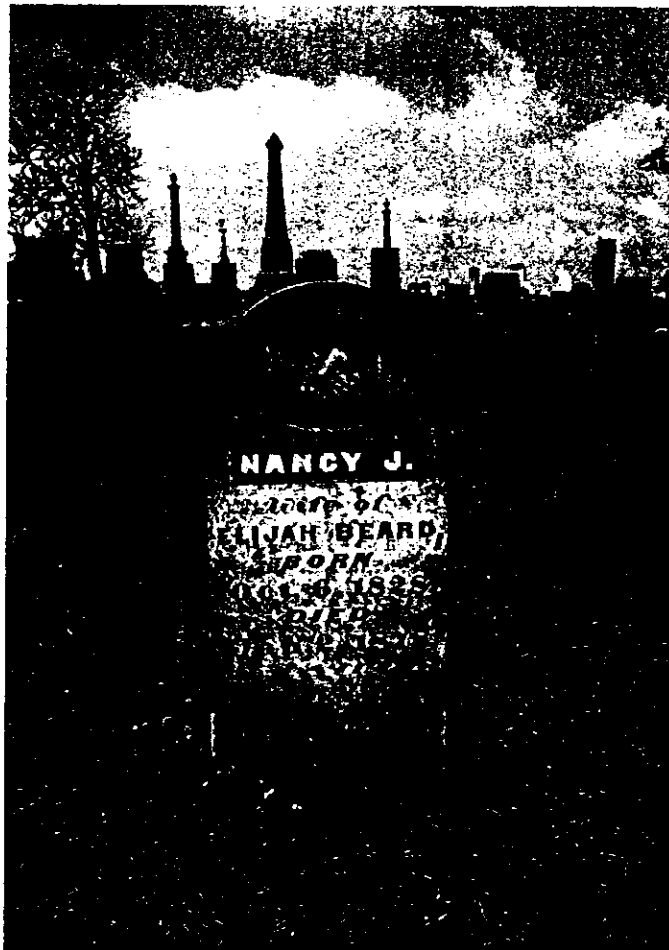

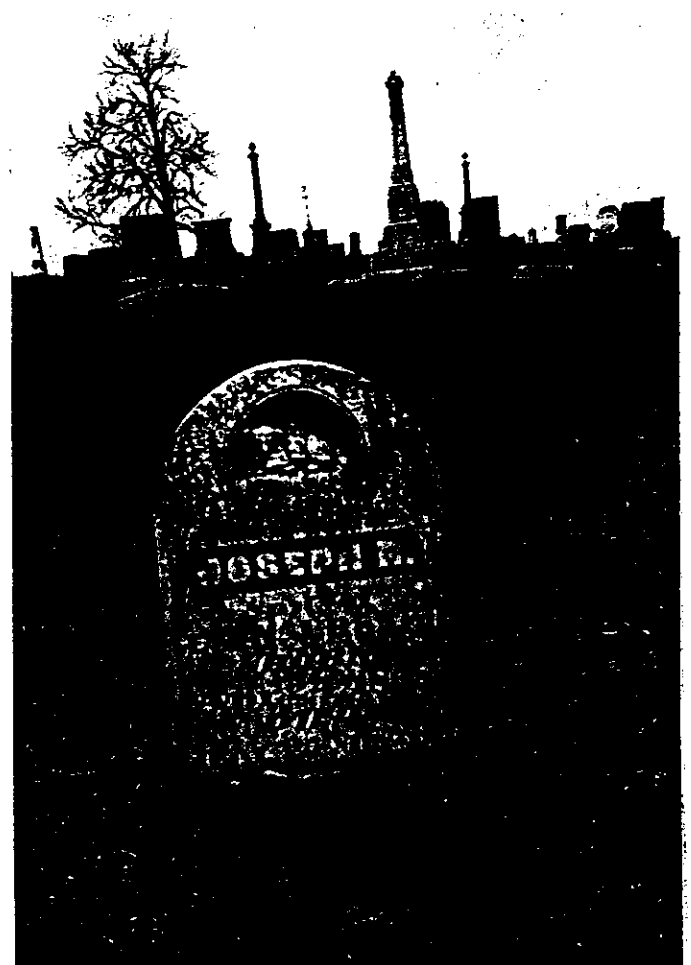

Moses Joseph Beard was born in 1859 & died in 1952 and is buried in Old Liberty Cemetery.

His parents were Moses Joseph and Susan(?) Simpson Beard. His brothers were George, Frank, Edward, Sam, Tom, Steve, Quint and John. His sisters were Betty, Lula and Seltie.

Moses Joseph Beard was married three times. His first wife was Lola Mc Murray Hall, the daughter of B.W. and L.M. Hall. She was born 1 July, 1869 and died 15 September 1889. They had two daughters: Lucy & Angie.

Moses Joseph Beard then married Angie Evans daughter of James Evans and Mary Q. Evans. She was born 23 March 1872 and died 20 April 1898. Angie died in childbirth.

His third wife was Sallie Evans Beard. She was born in 1874 and died in 1953. She was a sister of Angie Evans. They had five brothers: Coleman, Ike, Harry, Howard & David.
