

WOUNDED BEAUTY SHOP OPERATOR IN GRAVE STATE.

Mrs. Irene Beavers, 19 years old, 1013 South Third Street, Louisville opera or of the Health Studio, a beauty Shop at 320 West Chestnut Street, Saturday was reported in a serious condition at the City Hospital where she was under treatment for a bullet wound in her chest.

Detective Sergt. Carl Pitelko of the homicide squad said Mrs. Beavers told him she shot herself because she was in arrears with rent at her beauty shop and the place was to have been closed Friday night, according to the Louisville Times.

R. J. Berry, 55, of 320 West Chestnut Street, said Mrs. Beavers asked him to lend her a pistol for her protection. The weapon was found on the floor in the shop after Mrs. Beavers ran screaming into the hall and collapsed.

Mrs. Beavers, who formerly resided in Lebanon, is a daughter of George Alford, who went to Louisville this week to visit her at the hospital.
