I am looking for further information on the two, and on his father, Samuel Bullock, who moved to that county from Clark County, Indiana.

Based on separate information, I know that Charles had two brothers and two sisters (Tom, William, Betty, Bertha) surviving as of 1880, and I am presuming that they might have continued residence in the county.

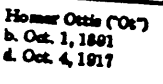
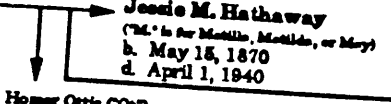
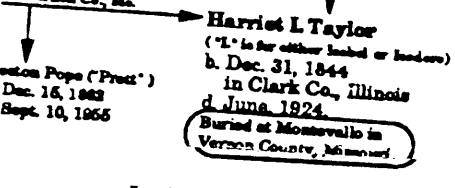
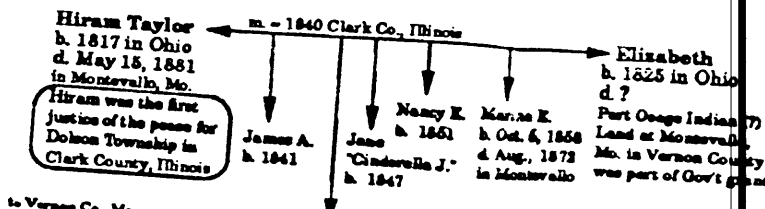
# Bullock Family

Our Bullock family probably descended from English Bullocks who emigrated to the New World as indentured servants on ships that landed in Maryland, St. Mary's Island, located at the mouth of the Wicomico River in St. Mary's County. At least five Bullocks from Maryland served in the Revolutionary War (1775-1778). Anna Bullock appears to be a connection to both the Bull and Buckler families through her marriages to James B. Robert Buckler. More information is currently available on the Buckler side of the family - with its roots traced back to a John Buckler, born in 1450 in Causeway, Dorset, England. In 1785 in Maryland a 'league' of slave families was formed - most being Catholic residents of St. Mary's County - who pledged to immigrate to Kentucky. Bullocks and Bucklers were part of this exodus (as well as Lee and Mattingly families). Our branch of Bullocks came through Thomas Bullock, apparently settled in Washington (Marion) County, Kentucky about 1796 prior to moving to Edgar County, Illinois in 1851 and later to Vernon County, Missouri in 1867.



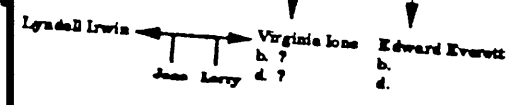
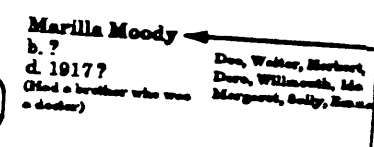
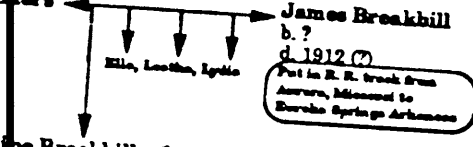
