HAD BEEN WED 50 YEARS

Emanuel Cambron, 77 years old, retired farmer, died Saturday afternoon, February 18th, at 1:15 o'clock at his home at Loretto. Death was due to paralysis, he having been stricken February 1st. 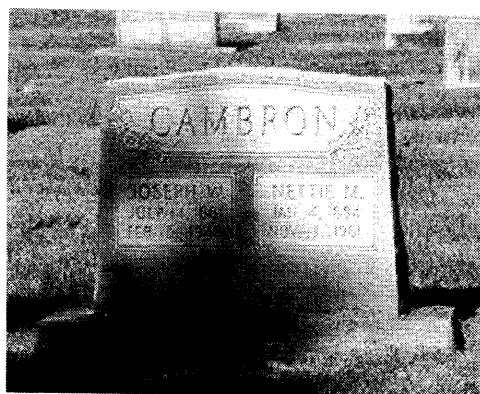

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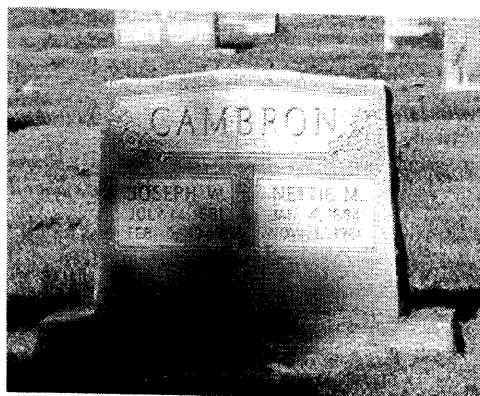
