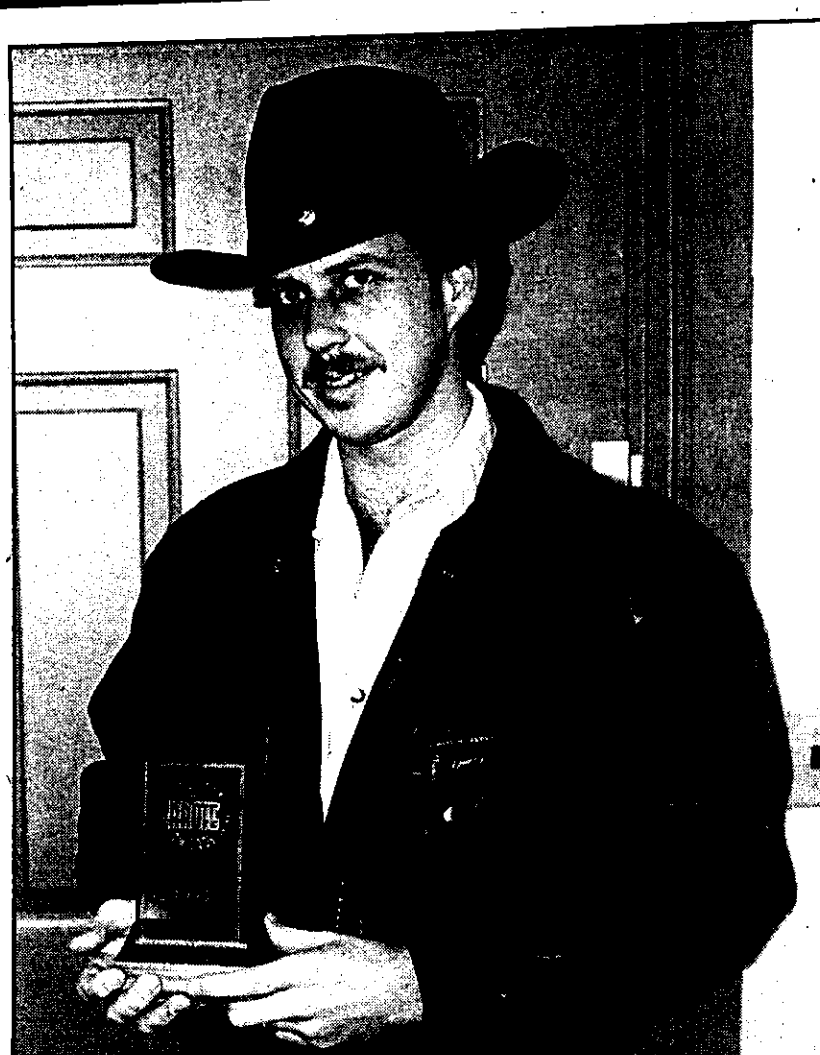

Clarkson honored with music award in Louisville

Country music entertainer Phillip Clarkson from Bradfordsville won a Roadrunner/Coyote's Video Music Award in Louisville on Jan. 15. In a crowded Coyote's nightclub on West Jefferson Street, Clarkson was thrilled and a little nervous when the announcement came that he was the winner of a 1995 RROTE Award in the category of Best Country Homegrown Video. Clarkson's winning video is titled "Doggie-Dog World." The Marion County native and 1982 graduate of Marion County High School was nominated for four other music awards. For his song, "We Had It All," Clarkson was nominated for Best Country Performance, Best Country Song, and Best Country Overall Video. For his song, "Room 223," he was nominated for Best Country Storyline/Concept.

Sixteen awards—eight country and eight rock—were presented at the event. There were five nominees in each category.

In accepting his award, Clarkson thanked his wife, K.T. Clarkson, Whispering Pines, Terry Cambron (Elvis), Mark Risinger, Matt Martingly, Donald Harrington, Judy Bobliut, Mary Doak, Beth Spalding, John Brady and Clan, Mary Jo and Sue, Joey Rigdon, Adam Tungate and Joe Pittman.

Clarkson also thanked Kathy and Bob Abell for doing the

videography for "We Had It All."

The annual music awards program, which was televised just in Jefferson County on Jan. 23, is to promote Louisville area musicians.

"I hope this will give me a little more recognition and help me get some shows in the Louisville and Lexington areas," said Clarkson.

He was nominated for two awards last year, for songs "Cold October Night" and "Lifestyles of the Broke and Poor."

Richway Records of Nashville is planning an album and several single releases on Clarkson for 1995, plus an overseas tour. Phillip still performs locally at the Fifth Wheel Lounge in Raywick on Wednesdays and the Whispering Pines on KY 49 between Lebanon and Bradfordsville on Thursdays.
