

Hi Guys,

I talked to Aunt Jane this evening (November 25). She said Uncle Russell had 6 kids. There were 4 girls - Dorothy, Ruby, Elizabeth and Mildred. There were two boys. She could only remember one of their names, Eddie.

She said their mother died first and she remembers Mildred and the two boys being put in an orphanage. She said she was young but she remembers feeling sad because the older girls didn't take the younger ones. But she couldn't remember if it was before or after Uncle Russell died. She did remember that Mildred lived with them when she got out of the orphanage, but she couldn't remember if Charlie and Essie got her before or after she was of age.

Mildred & the boys must have been in the orphanage before Uncle Russell died because I remember taking ice cream to him in the hospital when I was a child. I know I met Dorothy, Ruby and Elizabeth quite a few times and I think that they were several years older than my Mom (Carolyn). Mildred was a lot closer to Mom in age. I remember that we always went to see Mildred when we were in Michigan. She was always so glad to see us and wanted us to stay with them, but Aunt Florence and Aunt Joe always fought over us and we had to be divided between their houses in order to keep peace. Mom always referred to them as Dorothy Clayton, Ruby Clayton etc. but I never knew where they fit in the family tree.

Aunt Jane said that Dorothy and her husband owned a service station on 7th street and lived in the house next to the station.

She also said that Wanda's Dad's last name was Schuck (not sure of the spelling) and that's why they called him Schuckie. He didn't have much to do with Wanda. Aunt Jane and Wanda tracked him down one time and went to see him. He wouldn't answer the door but Wanda claimed he was there because she heard a radio playing. Mattie had been married at least once more before she married Joe Yunt. Evidently those husbands weren't very good to her so when she married Joe and he was so good to her everyone approved.

I don't know if this will help us or confuse us more.

Oh! Aunt Jane also reminded me that we use to go visit a Wes Medley in Holy Cross. I think he was a cousin to Grandma Essie. Several years ago Aunt Jane and I went to Holy Cross trying to sort some of this out. I took a lot of photos of gravestones if there was a chance they were related to us. I still have them. I'll have to get them out for January. I thought I had found Wes' house that time, too. I thought it was a two story house that sat on a curve. I am also thinking that Mildred had a son called Wes? Anyone else remember that?

I vaguely remember somebody telling me we were related to the Samuels (of Makers Mark). I also remember Uncle Grant telling about his days running Moonshine during Probation.

Grandma (Essie) told me one time that her parents had slaves. When they were set free they had no place to go so they stayed on the farm with the family. I have no idea who they were or what happened to them.

There use to be an "Aunt Marie" that was included in a lot of family get togethers. We called her "Aunt Marie" out of respect but I believe she was a cousin to Grandma Essie. She had lived in New York and been a buyer for Macy's or some big store there. When her husband died she moved to Louisville. Anybody remember her?

If you think of anything add it. This is fun with so many of us remembering things.

It's April. I do remember My mom (Wanda Shuck Dattilo) telling me when she was a little girl, Grandma Bivens (Alma) and her mom, Mattie Yunt taking her to the country to visit her relatives. She said it was in Holy Cross. They drove on road until it stopped and then went on in a horse wagon on a dirt road to a house. She said the house had a dirt floor. She also said that her great grandma didn't smile much and she didn't like her (Wanda)

The Story about us being related to the Samuels is: The Burks family owned the distillery in Loretto before Probation. Callie Burks Clayton was Grandma Alma Bivens mother. Callie was the daughter of the Burks family that ran the distillery. I had Bill Samuels and Mattie Yunt at my house a few years back and they shared a lot of memories about the family. The Samuels bought the distillery from the Burks. I think it was real run down, and illegal at the time to make whiskey. And we all know the rest of that story.

You are going to have to make me a family tree. I need a program to understand all this family.

It sure was fun to see all of you on Saturday. I am going to get some pictures together and bring them in Jan. Thanks for getting us altogether. Sincerely, April

# Burks-Clayton Family Feud of 1884

## A Dark Family Secret Brought to Light

My maternal grandmother was Mary Pearl Burks (Pearl), daughter of the Richard Floyd Burks, III (Dick) that this story is about. Pearl's mother was Anna Florence Clayton, whose father was Robert Green Clayton. Both were good Catholic Marion County, Kentucky families.

Grandma always said her father, Dick, lost one arm from a woodworking accident, and that her grandfather, Green, was shot and killed during a posse hunt. A newspaper clipping found in her effects recently tells the real story. These events all happened four years before her own birth.

In 1884, the Burks and Clayton families were involved in a feud. At the end of the feud, two of my ancestors were dead and two were wounded.

My Great-Great Grandfather, Robert Green Clayton was one of the unfortunate

two killed. According to an account in the *Daviess County Messenger*, one of Green Clayton's sons, Laurence Clayton, attempted to court one of the Burks girls. Family lore says that Laurence had dated a black girl. "His visits did not please Mr. Burks' family and he was asked to discontinue them. This angered Clayton and he made abusive remarks about Floyd Burks' son, Dick, who had married his sister." Dick Burks had married Anna Florence Clayton, Laurence's twin sister, a year earlier at Holy Cross Church! The article states that on three occasions, Laurence came around to visit the Burks girl, only to have words with her brothers: Washington, Samuel, and Dick. On his fourth visit, Laurence Clayton was armed, and accompanied by his unarmed father, Green Clayton.

Patriarch Floyd Burks "made an effort to preserve the peace, but failed. Firing began, and at the first shot, Washington Burks fell, shot in the breast. He died in twenty minutes. Green Clayton was killed next. Laurence was wounded in the side and breast... Dick Burks was wounded in the wrist." The wrist wound apparently eventually led to the loss of his lower arm.

No one was arrested. Laurence was placed "under guard." Family lore says that Laurence was ordered to leave the area with a promise to never come back! He is thought to have moved to Colorado. Samuel Burks moved to Texas. Our guess is that Sam must have fired the fatal shot to Green, as we can't imagine Dick killing his own father-in-law!

Green Clayton's widow, Amanda Fogle Clayton (1836-1921) was left with six children ages four to seventeen to raise.

Francis Warren Clayton was born January 29, 1860. Warren as his family called him was raised in Marion County, Kentucky. He was the son of James Carlon Clayton (born November 1, 1821 in Warren County, Kentucky) and Eliza Ellen Dawson (born October 1, 1829).

Mary Caroline "Callie" Burks was born April 6, 1862. Callie was the daughter of Anna Sevilla Cissell (Cecil) who was born in 1832 and died 1894 and Richard Floyd Burks. Richard Floyd Burks was born 1826 in Marion County, Kentucky and died 1896 in Nelson County, Kentucky. Anna Sevilla was the daughter of Hendrick Medley and Sylvester Cissell who both died in the Asiatic Cholera Epidemic of 1833. Anna and her siblings were raised by the Medley grandparents. Hendrick was the daughter of Ignatius Medley and Sarah Boone.

Warren and Callie were married 12-6-1886 in Lebanon, Kentucky. O.G. Kelly was the County Judge who married them. Witnesses were James Gardner and Henry Gardner. They had 12 children with only seven surviving to adulthood. They are Mary Alma, Anthony, Joseph Russell, Mary Florence, Mary Joa, Thomas Grant, and Mary Essie.

Callie (died 1933) and Warren (died May 8, 1927) are buried in St. Michael Cemetery in Louisville, Kentucky.

The only person who ever mentioned (that our generation remembers) Anthony was Aunt Mary Jo who told Marietta Washburn Urban when she was a young girl. She said he was a window washer of tall buildings and lost his footing falling to his death. Aunt Jo only mentioned it that one time. Mary said she never talked about her family background.






