Moses Coppedge 1735-1801 moved at an early age to Prince William County, Virginia, where in 1756 he was a foot soldier against the French; in this same year he qualified to receive his share of his father Charles' estate, having previously been left a bequest by his uncle James; he was on the Fauquier Rent Roll, 1770 for 275 acres of land; he married Mary Jane Catlett, daughter of John, son of William, son of David, son of Nicholas, son of Sir John Catlett from Sittingburne in Kent; Mary Jane was related in some way to Lord Fairfax, whose coach passed down in the Catlett family, and the door is now a carved tobacco stand; Mary Jane descended from a sister (Anne) of the great Sir Francis Bacon through the Woodhouses and Meriwethers; she was related in some way to the family of Col. Raleigh Travers of Lancaster. The Coppedges moved to Kentucky about 1777-9 and handed down a tradition of life in forts; two sons, William and Alexander, were wounded by Indians, the latter mortally.

This George may have been the Revolutionary Soldier of 1780 in Fairfax, who was born in 1760 1760 in Stafford County; if so he would have been eldest child. he named Rolla, Missouri (for Raleigh, N. C.)

Mary (Polly) Coppage (1775-1822) married Robert Burnett, nephew of Catlett Burnett, in 1796. Robert was born in Virginia, September 21, 1773; died in Marion County 1828. Washington County record of marriage March 14, 1796 with consent of Moses and Jane Coppage. He was called " Gove ".

Perhaps it may be selfishness that holds us back from voicing our thanks, or our congratulations, or our words of condolence to our friends, and the letter is not written and the debt is not paid. Sometimes it is ignorance or inexperience or self-consciousness; we do not realize that the conventions of society require that we should pay these obligations, just as we must call after we have been to a dinner party, or must pay the gas bill before the tenth of the month if we expect the discount.

Nothing brings more pleasure than the unexpected personal letter, the gracious note of thanks, or a line of congratulations when one has met with happiness or good fortune. It's like getting an unexpected check from home, or having your salary raised, or finding a \$5 bill in an old pair of trousers.

Don't come in on a freight train. Christmas letters should get off before Easter; letters of congratulation should not be delayed until the event has lost its joy or has been forgotten. If interscholastic is in May, you should write your letter of thanks before August. Even from a purely selfish point of view it would be a good thing to learn and practice the art of paying these social debts. There are few things that bring one surer favor, or that give one better standing with one's friends than a reputation for thoughtfulness in letter writing.

An early map included in the first Washington County Deed Book shows the North and South Forks of the Rolling Fork with an area labeled Kinnett Springs on the North Fork of the River. The first record of land ownership shows Uriah owning a farm on the South Fork of the River. This farm is where James and Nancy first lived after their marriage. This farm has been in the family since that time and is now owned by Linnie Raney, a great great grand daughter. The original house believed to be the house where James and Nancy set up housekeeping after their marriage is still standing albeit it is in poor condition.

James' brother William was shot by an Indian, but survived and later moved to Missouri. James stayed in Kentucky living on the farm until his death. He and Nancy are buried on an adjacent farm belonging to Travis Coppage at the time of their death.

The above includes information from Perrin's History of Kentucky. Perrins also says "He had but little school training, his education being almost entirely practical; his vocation through life has been that of a farmer; he has been uniformly successful in his business operations. He has resided all his life on the farm where he was born. He is a proprietor of 300 acres of farming land, has been a nab of energy and perseverance, and has followed his vocation with the zeal that brings success, and now in his declining years is able to live in comfortable circumstances. Mr and Mrs. Coppage are members of the Christian Church. His political views are Democratic."

MOTOR TRUCK IS DESTROYED

Catches Fire.

NO INSURANCE ON LOSS

A tank truck containing 318 gallons of coal oil caught fire and was destroyed on the county road between St. Mary's and Loretto a few mornings ago. Leonard Feathers, driver of the truck, escaped injury. The machine was the property of J. C. Weatherford, of this city, while the kerosene belonged to the Hawkeye Oil Company, of Waterloo, Iowa. Mr. Weatherford is the representative of the company in this city. There was no insurance on either the truck or the oil. Mr. Weatherford's loss will, it is thought, be around \$900.

Examination of the wrecked machine after the fire leads to the belief that the gasoline feed line running from the tank to the carburetor broke, allowing the gasoline to spill on the hot exhaust pipe. The flames enveloped the engine so quickly the driver narrowly escaped being burned.

DEATH CLAIMS JAMES COPPAGE

Well Known Bradfordsville Man
Succumbs In Shreveport,
Louisiana.

James Coppage, widely known in the Bradfordsville section where he was born and reared and where the greater part of his long and useful life was spent, died Monday afternoon at the home of his son, William H. Coppage, in Shreveport, La. He had been in poor health for some time, the result of a kidney disorder, but the immediate cause of his death was paralysis. He was stricken several days before his death, and because of his advanced age little hope for his recovery was entertained. He was 90 years old.

The body arrived here Wednesday evening on the 7 o'clock train and was removed to Bosley & Son's chapel. Yesterday morning it was taken to Bradfordsville where services were held at the Christian church, conducted by the Rev. C. W. Noel. Burial was in Old Liberty cemetery by the side of his wife.

Mr. Coppage was in many respects a remarkable man. He retained his mental faculties to an unusual degree, and until in recent months was as active as a man many years younger. Although old in years he was young at heart, and in talking to friends always referred to himself as a "boy." Some time ago he went to Springfield, Mo., where for quite a while he made his home with his son, Thomas B. Coppage, who is president of the St. Louis & San Francisco Railroad, one of the big railroad systems of the West. However, he returned to his old home in this county several months ago and remained here for a while when he left for Shreveport to be with his son in that city.

His wife, who was Miss Amanda Batsell, died about thirty years ago. Other than his two sons, Mr. Coppage is survived by four sisters, Mrs. Ben F. Ellis, of Modesto, Ill.; Mrs. Willis Malone, of Casey county, and Mrs. Pryor Swiggett and Mrs. A. L. Brown, of this county, and three brothers, Hardin and Moses A. MARION NATIVE DIES IN SOUTH

James Coppage, 90, Passed
Away at Home of Son in
Shreveport, La.

BURIAL AT OLD LIBERTY

James Coppage, ninety years old, a former resident of this county, died last Monday afternoon, December 15th, at the home of his son, William H. Coppage, in Shreveport, Louisiana. He had been in Shreveport on a visit to this son for only about three months, having spent the past several years with his only other son, Thomas B. Coppage, in Springfield, Missouri. The latter is president of the St. Louis & San Francisco Railroad. Just before going to Shreveport, Mr. Coppage spent several weeks at his old home in this county. He was born and reared in the Bradfordsville community, where he spent most of his life.

The immediate cause of Mr. Coppage's death was a stroke of paralysis, which he suffered several days before the end came. However, he had been in bad health from a kidney ailment for some time.

The body was shipped here for burial, arriving in Lebanon on the seven o'clock train Wednesday evening and was taken to the chapel of Bosley & Son. Thursday morning the remains were taken to Bradfordsville, where funeral services were conducted by the Rev. C. W. Noel at the Christian church. The burial was in Old Liberty cemetery by the side of his wife, who preceded him to the grave about thirty years ago. Before marriage she was Miss Amanda Batsel.

He is survived by his two sons, above named; four sisters, Mrs. Lafa Brown, Mrs. Prior Swigger and Mrs. Willis Malone, of this county, and Mrs. Ben F. Ellis, of Madison, Illinois; and by three brothers, Harry, George and Moses, of Coppage, Mo.

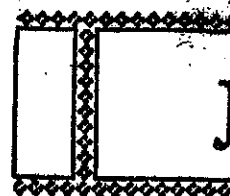
