- To the extent possible, we would like to have:

- Pictures of : the individual, individual's spouse, individual's tombstone with location-(county and cemetery name), and home with location.

An ancestral chart starting with a living descendant (or relative) going back to the Confederate or a close relative such as a brother, uncle, or cousin.

A family chart showing the Confederate, his parents, his spouse, and his children with whom each child married along with dates of birth, dates of marriage, and dates of death where the form asks for it.

Certainly we would like to have interesting information about the Confederate.

In most cases, we would like for this information to be limited to four pages since we hope to make several copies and files on each individual.
