## Lambe-Faulkner

Sept. 16, 1934

Miss Helen Lambe of Bloomington, Ind., sister of the bride, was the bridesmaid, and the groom's best man was his cousin, Joseph Faulkner of Campbellsville. The ushers were Milton Goodwin of this city and Ralph Faulkner of Campbellsville, cousin of the groom. Little Miss Bettie Carol Smith was the ring-bearer.
