Could you send me card information and number of pages on a book, file or biographical data in the Marion County Public Library about the Fenwick families of Marion-Washington Counties. I am trying to find out if your holdings would warrant a visit to Lebanon, or for limited data if zerox copies could be requested. In 1810 these included: Edward (O.P.), Thomas, Richard and Henry from census data at the Kenton County Library.

St. Francis teen dies in wreck

A St. Francis man was killed when the car he was riding in ran off the road and into a creek Monday night.

According to Kentucky State Police, Joey Blandford, 17, was dead upon arrival at Norton Spring View Hospital after he sustained injuries in an accident just after 10 p.m.

Blandford was one of three passengers in a 1994 Chevy driven by William W. Corbett IV, 19, of Lexington.

A state police news release stated that the car was traveling east on KY 152 a mile and a half outside of Loretto when it left the roadway and crashed in a creek.

Corbett was treated and released at Spring View along with David Wethington, 16, of Loretto and Floyd Neal, Jr., 15, of Loretto.

No one in the vehicle was wearing a seatbelt, the release states.

Two other accidents occurred on Sunday causing injuries.

In one wreck a Lebanon woman was seriously injured Sunday night, according to a Kentucky State Police press release.

Ann Fenwick, 17, of Lebanon was traveling south on KY 289 in a 1996 Toyota when she left the road and struck a tree.

Fenwick was flown to the University of Louisville Hospital and was still in the emergency room Monday afternoon. The hospital would not release information about her condition.

Fenwick was wearing a seatbelt, the state police report states.

In an unrelated accident Sunday, Francis M. Campbell, 50, of Lebanon was traveling west on KY 84 in a 1983 Ford Ranger when he ran off the road and ran into a utility pole.

Campbell was taken to Norton Spring View Hospital where he was treated and released.

Campbell was wearing his seatbelt, the release states.

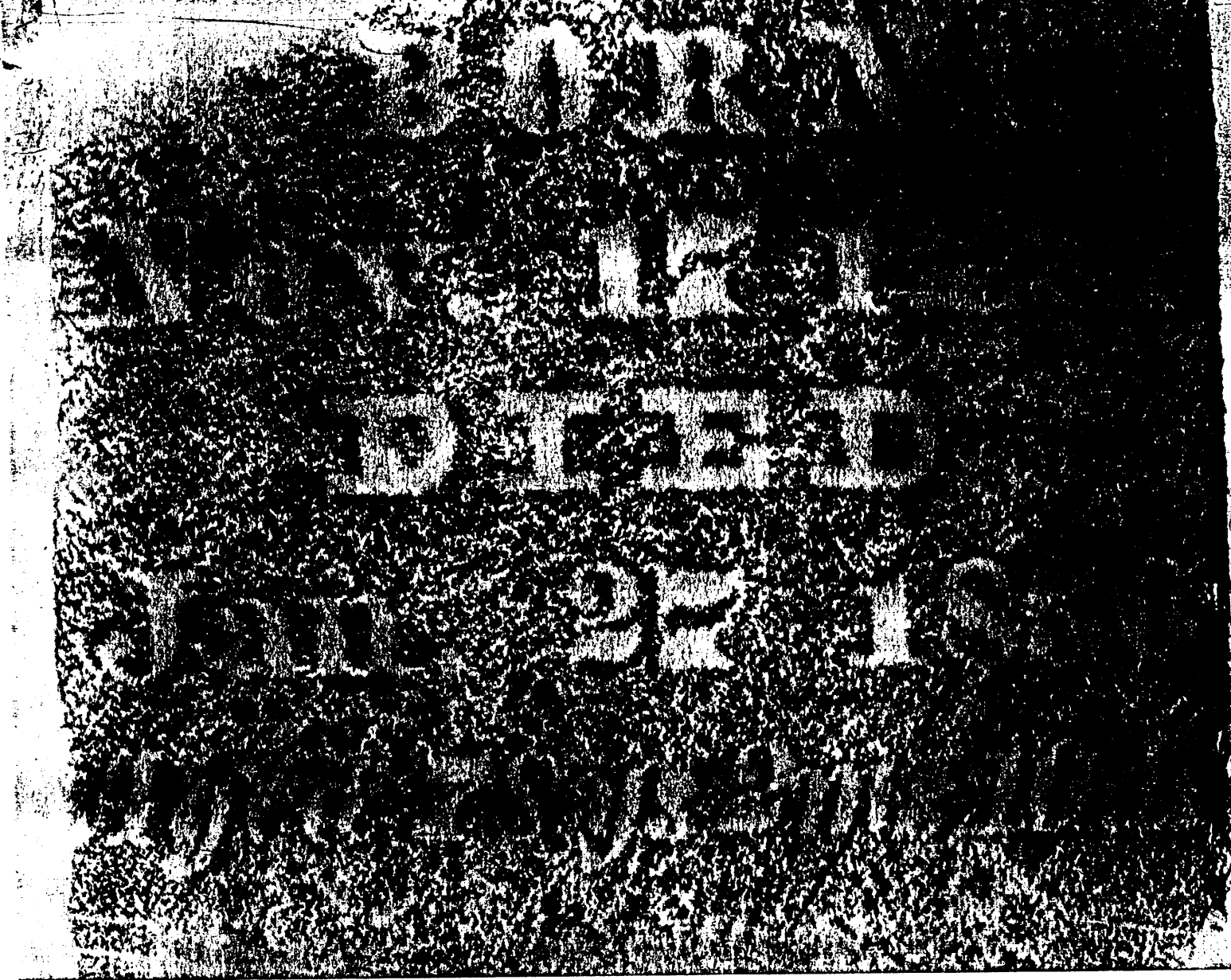

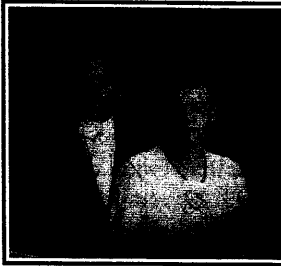


Ben Ewing and Mae Dunn

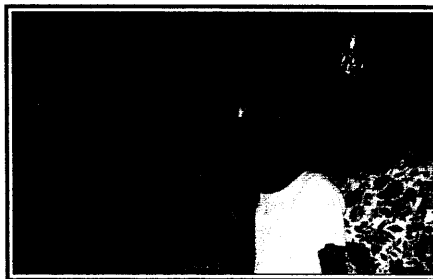

FENWICK

Benjamin Fenwick, b. ca 1774 and his wife, Ann, b. ca 1865, appear to have migrated to Kentucky from Maryland along with the "Catholic Colonization League". Benjamin first appears on the Washington County tax rolls in August 1796. By October 1871, he owned land on the Rolling Fork, where he lived until his death (around 1843). He acquired an additional 150 acres on the south side of Rolling Fork as a result of a lawsuit against Joseph Byrn of Nelson County.

Benjamin and Ann had five children: Sarah Ann who m. William Smith about February 10, 1811. (They subsequently moved to Daviess County, Indiana, based on an affidavit 6 of her 9 children filed in her brother, Cornelius's probate estate.); Ellen Fenwick, who appears to have never married; Cornelius Fenwick, who m. Louisa Boarman about February 8, 1827; Benjamin J. Fenwick who m. Elizabeth Martin, daughter of Samuel Lee Martin and Mary Leake O'Daniel, about October 19, 1830 (They subsequently moved to Davis County and McLean County, Kentucky based on affidavits filed in Cornelius's probate.); John Fenwick, m. Elizabeth's sister Ellender about May 24, 1821. After Ellender's death John m. Rebecca Thompson.

John Fenwick's will, which was probated in Marion County in 1876, after his death mentions his four oldest sons by his first marriage. Those children were Cornelius, Wilford, Thomas and John, Jr. Cornelius m. Celia Ann Cissell, d. of Martin V. Cissell (s. of Jeremiah Cissell and Mary Vessels) and Mary Catherine "Kitty" Martin (yet another daughter of Samuel Lee Martin and Mary Leake Darnell). Cornelius and Celia Ann's children include Sophronia Fenwick, who married Isaac V. Brewer (s. of William Allen Brewer and Mary Jane Stillwell of Ginseng, LaRue Co).

The 1850 Marion County Census

lists Ann as a farmer who was born in Maryland. Ann also appears as a witness to a consent on an 1820 marriage bond between John Boone and Catherine Greenwell in Nelson County (Ignatius Greenwell signed the bond and Catherine's father, Joshua Greenwell gave his consent. Ignatius and Ann were witnesses to Joshua's consent.)

James Tarrence Flanagan (1760-1822) was born in Cork County Ireland. His oath of Fidelity is recorded in Baltimore County Maryland. The year was 1778. He remained in Baltimore, Maryland until 1783. He m.. Elizabeth Roney, circa 1786. By 1790, he was in Kentucky. He moved from Mercer County in 1797 to what is now Marion County, Kentucky. He bought a small farm of 107 acres between St. Joe and Raywick, Kentucky. Tarrence and Elizabeth had ten children: Patrick m. Catherine French; Mary m. James McAlister; James remained single; John m. Sussana Buckman; Margaret remained single; Nancy m. John Mills, Jr.; Stephen remained single; Elizabeth m. George Buckman; Catherine became Sister Bibanna (S.L.) and Benedict m. Mary Jane Russell

Benedict Joseph Flanagan (1812-1882). According to tax records, Benedict Joseph Flanagan Sr. purchased a farm 2 and 1/2 miles from St. Mary's, Kentucky on Hardins Creek in 1844. It is the Flanagan farm located now on Sam Browning Road. Benedict m. Mary Jane Russell in 1845, d/o James and Nancy (Mudd) Russell. Ten children were born of this union: James Tarrence m. Eliza Walker; William Patrick m. Mildred Hollis; John Albert m. Eliza Hamilton; Amanda Catherine m. William C. Hamilton; Elizabeth Francis m. Jim (Ed) Mattingly; Benedict, Jr. m. Nannie Pike; Annie Mary m. Bernard Mattingly; Charles Kendrick m. Florence Clayton; Sarah Eliza remained single and Thomas David m. Louis Cynthia Pike.

Thomas David Flanagan (1869-1947). After the death of Mary Jane Flanagan, Thomas married Cynthia Louise Pike, d/o John Pike and Anna Minerva (Vittitow) Pike, in 1875. Six children were born of this union: Mary

Lea became Sister Mary Angela (S.C.); Joseph Elbert m. Mary Burke; Joseph Edward m. Catherine Roberta Mudd; Althea David m. Joseph William Ray; John Thomas m. Roberta O'Bryan and Ida m. Ernest Byrley.

Joseph Edward Flanagan, Sr. (1900-1988). In 1947, Thomas David Flanagan deeded to his son the farm. Joseph Edward Flanagan, Sr. "Ed" m. Catherine Roberta Mudd, d/o Martin John and Teresa Barbara Blandford Mudd on November 25, 1937. Their eight children include: Joseph Edward, Jr. m. Carolyn Hardy; Francis Jerome m. Mary Ann Rice; Mary Cecilia m. Kenneth Slater; Frances Patricia m. David Langly; Barbara Alice m. Benedict Miles; Charles Louis m. Alice Peters; Dorothy Jean m. David Kehm; Teresa Martin m. Larry Richard Hawkins.

Charles Gerard Flanagan (7/27/72 -) "Charlie" bought the Flanagan farm and built a new house on the location of the original Flanagan homestead. Charlie married Jacqueline Renee (Pinkston) Abell. Jackie had a daughter from a previous marriage, Courtney Ann Renee Abell. One child was born to Charles and Jackie, Charles, Jr. (5/11/99). The Flanagan farm has been in the same name for 156 years.

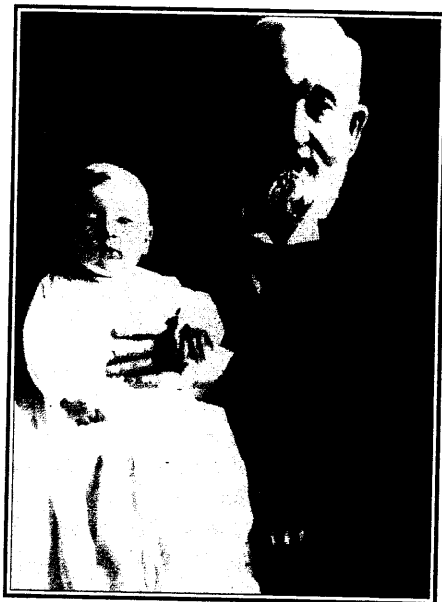
FLEECE FAMILY.

Robert Fleece came to America in 1643 and settled in Henrico Co., VA. John Fleece (1756), s/o Nicholas of Morgan County, VA., joined the Continental Line at Winchester, VA. in September 1775. In 1779 he joined Light Horse Harry Lee's Legion as a Cavalryman and fought in the Revolutionary War.

The first Fleece family to live in Marion County was Dr. James Fleece (s/o John and Mary Withers Fleece) and wife Dinah Penick. They married in 1825 in Washington Co. and had four children: William E., Fannie, Edward B. and Mary A. Fleece. He practiced medicine in Lebanon from 1830 until his death in 1858. He is buried in Ryder Cemetery

His wife remarried in 1868 to James V. Mahon.

In the articles "Lebanon as I have known it", C. A. Johnston says, "On the corner of Mulberry and Main Streets was the home of Doctor James Fleece, for

many years the leading physician here. He had a large and handsome frame residence and in the eastern part of it was his office and Doctor's shop, as we called them in those days before drug stores, when each physician carried his own medicine in stock."

Dr. Edward B. Fleece (1836) (s/o James) was also a physician and farmer in Marion Co. He m. Louisa Maria Ames in 1868 and had two children. He was appointed by the Marion County Court in October 9, 1879 to be the physician for the jail for one year. His salary was \$71.50 per year. He later moved to Florida and died there.

Dr. John Logan Fleece (s/o Nicholas and grandson of John & Mary) with wife Mary Nash came to Marion Co. about 1835. They had six children all born in Marion County: Emily Jane m. Merritt Newcomb; Caroline m. John Purdy; William & Anne died young and are buried in Old Liberty Cemetery; John Clinton who moved to Texas at age 22 and Frances Marion. Dr. John Logan Fleece was an excellent doctor, lived about two
