Dear Sir or Madam:

I am working on the history of my husband's family, and I am looking for information on some of his ancestors who lived in Marion County in the 1800's. His great-great grandparents, Uriah Gartin and Eliza Jane Elder, lived in Bradfordsville at the time of the 1850 census. Uriah was still living there as a widower in 1880. My husband's great-grandmother, Sarah Martha Gartin, their daughter, was born there in 1853.

Is it possible to get a photocopy of birth records in Marion County from 1848-1862? We are trying to figure out just who Sarah's siblings were and where they were born. If there are death records, we would love to see those too. Death records would be most useful for the period 1848-1870, because we know that Uriah was a widower by 1870, but we don't know when Eliza died.

We have recently learned that Uriah Gartin died in New Albany, Indiana, on November 21, 1912. The tiny obituary in the New Albany paper said that he had been in New Albany for three years. I thought that perhaps there was an obituary in the Lebanon newspaper, since that is where he was better known. Would it be possible to get a copy of that obituary if it exists?

Any help that you can give us will be appreciated. I am enclosing a self-addressed envelope, and I'm glad to pay for photocopies. Thank you.

Funeral Rites Held For Horace C. Gartin

Horace C. Gartin, 81, died of a heart condition at 3:15 p.m. Sunday, April 23, at Mary Immaculate Hospital. He had been hospitalized for two weeks and had been in declining health for about four months.

He operated a general mercantile store at Bradfordsville for 18 years, and after his retirement in 1946, he attended to his farming interest. At one time he managed a Ford agency here, and later, with his uncle, formed a partnership, Gozette and Gartin Motor Company, a Dodge agency. He was a member of the Bradfordsville Christian Church.

Born February 15, 1886, he was a son of the late George and Rosa Thornton Gartin. He was married to Ruth Hagan,

who died in 1938, and later married Myrtle Crews, who survives.

Surviving, besides his wife, are a son, Hagan Gartin, Louisville, and a sister, Mrs. John Purdy, Bradfordsville.

The body was at Don V. Drye Funeral Home. The Rev. Ronald Dow, assisted by the Rev. Charles Wooley, conducted the funeral services there at 2 p.m. Tuesday. Burial was in Old Liberty Cemetery.

Mrs. Gartin Dies At Bradfordville

Funeral services for Mrs. Ruth Hagan Gartin, wife of Horace Gartin, retired Bradfordville businessman, will be held at 2 p.m. today at Drye Funeral Home.

Mrs. Gartin, 73, died at 10:30 p.m. Wednesday at her home at Bradfordville. Death was attributed to cancer.

A Marion County native, daughter of the late William and Carrie Wilson Hagan, she lived here until her marriage in 1911. Her husband was an automobile salesman in Lebanon and, later, in Louisville.

In 1929 she and her husband opened a general merchandise store in Bradfordville and continued operating it until 1946 when they sold the business and retired.

Surviving, besides her husband, are a son, Hagan Gartin, and a sister, Mrs. Nora Tharp, both of Louisville.

Funeral services this afternoon will be conducted by the Rev. Howard O'Bannon, pastor of Bradfordville Methodist Church, of which Mrs. Gartin was a member. Burial will be in Old Liberty Cemetery.

Please find inclosed the death notice for Mrs. Gartin who died in 1924. I have also inclosed the cemetery record providing Mr. Gartin's birth and death information. I could not find an obituary for Mr Gartin in 1901. I checked the entire month of September and October with no success. From his wife's obituary in 1924 it indicated that he had died 20 years previous. Unfortunately we only have one edition of the Lebanon Enterprise for 1904 and it is a January edition. Did Mr. Gartin have family in one of the surrounding counties that may have reported his death in their local paper? We don't have copies of any surrounding newspapers but you might be able to find a notice of his death in them.

GARTIN FAMILY RECORD

The earliest known name of this particular family is that of Uriah Garton. It is believed by the author that he is a direct descendant of William Garton of Lancaster County, Virginia, whose will was probated in 1709.

William Garton had sons, Uriah, ^{or} James and Anthony. Uriah and James bought land in the Shenandoah Valley in 1726. Uriah had a wife, Winifred, who is mentioned in many land transactions and in his will, probated in 1755. His sons were, Zachariah, ^{or looks like he sold property in Spots Co} Uriah (a house carpenter), and ^{wife Mary} Elijah, (a planter). To date no record of this Uriah's descendants have been found, and he may have been the Uriah who went to Kentucky, and founded a line from which the Uriah of this line descended. ^{also in 1755 + 1759 still 300 acres still in Spots Co in 1762}

The families in that time moved in groups for protection. In Rockingham Co. Virginia, we had family names of Garton, Houston, Devier, Wray, Wisdom, Boyd, Miller, etc. These same names are found in the record of the descendants of Uriah Gartin of Kentucky.

The descendants of the Pioneer Gartin into Kentucky have not been able to agree on the first ancestor, but from a comparison of records and available dates, the author has determined that the name of Uriah Gartin should be given precedence over any other name.

The names in this genealogy are arranged according to generations by Roman Numerals, and each entry is given a serial number. If that name is referred to again on a later page an asterisk is placed after the name.

My father's farm joined Uncle Uriah's. I was born there. His youngest daughter Lizzie that married Ben Mac Larary was almost the same age as I was. Uncle Uriah was a very rich man. Had so many negroes that the cabins looked like a town. He was a grand man. His horse was saddled every morning and brought to the gate. He would ride all day among the negroes. His wife was a wonderful woman. She would work all day in the loom house with the negro women, where they spun flax and wove the cloth that made their clothes.

I have heard mother say Uncle Uriah killed 50 to 75 hogs for their meat. He and his family used to go to church every Sunday. He never sold any niggers.

Uncle Stephen H. Gartin -- he had a farm and negroes. They stayed with him after they were freed.

Stephen H. Gartin's brother George married Rose Thornton.

Uncle Uriah Gartin, my great uncle rather, had three wives. First wife, Eliza Peyton. Second wife, widow Hays, my father's sister. Third wife, Widow Baker. They had three children, two boys and a girl. Hester Mays. (my father's dad & mother) page 5

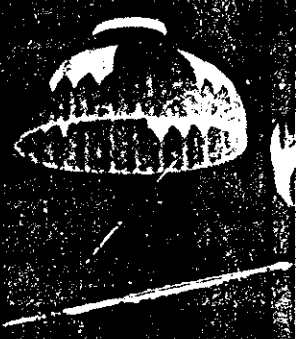

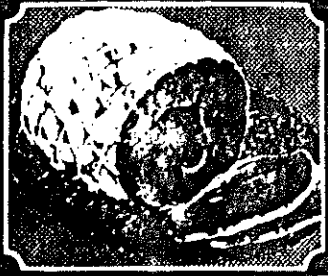

Washington county, before the organization of Marion, was for many years entitled to three representatives, and from the above list it will be observed that on several occasions that part of the county, now Marion, furnished two of the three, and in the year 1802 furnished three. As to Charles Ewing, John Grundy and Christ. Huts in the above list, as to whether they were residents in Marion county at the time of their election, there may be some doubt, since it is known that all three at one time were residents there is likely no mistake in their being placed from the territory now Marion.

Subsequent to the establishment of Marion county names and dates of Senators and Representatives as before stated, James Dever in 1834-35, Ben Spalding 1835. These were elected from Marion county, and represented Washington as well, being before provision was made for separate representation. The following are the names and dates of Senators and Representatives elected from Marion county since its organization, or since 1836. It will be remembered that Washington and Marion counties have still a joint representation by Senators, and since then the organization of Taylor county, Washington, Marion and Taylor constitute Senatorial District.

On the 29th of Feb., 1836, the apportionment bill allowing Marion county a separate representation, became a law, and from that day to the present time the following senators and representatives have been elected:

Senators--James Schooling, in 1837; John S. Medley, 1849; James P. Barbour, 1850; Ben Spalding, 186; R. A. Burton, 1869; John D. Fogle; 1861; R. H. Wathen, 1892.

Representatives--B. Rowan Hardin, in 1836; L. A. Spalding, 1837, E. C. Purdy, 1838; C. S. Hill, 1839; John Shuck, 1840; James P. Barbour, 1841; Jesse Abell, 1842; B. K. Penick, 1843; E. A. Graves, 1844; Cornelius Raley, 1845; E. A. Graves, 1846; Cornelius Raley, 1847; J. M. Boarnan, 1848, W. T. Hamilton, 1849; E. C. Purdy, 1850; Thomas J. Nash, 1851; Cornelius Raley, 1853; James C. Fogle, 1855; J. M. Boarnan, 1857; R. A. Burton, 1859; John R. Thomas, 1861, 1863, 1865; R. H. Spalding, 1867, 1869; E. A. Graves, 1871, 1873; Ralph Spalding, 1875, 1877; Alson Rawlings, 1879; J. P. Thompson, 1881; S. A. Russel, 1883; Nicholas Wathen, 1885; H. P. Cooper, 1887; C. C. Spalding, 1889, 1891; Dr. W. W. Cleaver, 1893.

Since the adoption of the new constitution, Representatives are elected every two years instead of every year as under the old constitution. Dr. Green Forrest was delegate

sufficiently unburdened as to allow it to float off into deep water, then it was reloaded and floated on. In this way many boatmen lost their lives. One young man, Joseph Ray, born and raised on the farm then occupied by James M. Miller and who was a brother to Mr. Miller's wife, lost his life on one of these flat boats. He and his brother, Martin Ray, were selling goods at Raywick and trading at New Orleans in whisky and bacon. On one of the last boats that went out the Rolling Fork young Ray embarked, and, an accident occurring just after starting, it became necessary to float the whisky ashore in doing this, having been in the water a long time, by chill and exhaustion and cramping, he was drowned.

The last boat from Raywick was built in 1839 by Joseph P. Knott, above Raywick, several miles, and sold to Col. Wm. Ray, who sent it out loaded with bacon and lard.

Another feature in the trade and commerce of our county, prior as well as subsequent to its establishment, was the trade in hogs and horses. Horses were purchased and driven to the Southern States in droves of from thirty to fifty head by N. S. Ray, Sr., Richard Spalding, Ben Spalding and D. and J. G. Phillips, who were the most prominent traders. The principal hog traders were Ben Spalding, Stephen Gartin, Sr., Wm. Douglas, Felix B. Grundy and others at later date. Hogs at that day were driven on foot to Georgia, the Carolinas, Alabama and Mississippi. From six to eight miles per day for the first week, afterwards as many as sixteen or even eighteen miles, were made each day. We may infer that in those days the hog for market was appreciated more for his traveling qualities than for his corpulency or fatness. Prices for hogs on foot in those days ranged from \$1.75 to \$2.75 per hundred. The owners of the hogs after selling out returned on horseback with the proceeds in his saddle pockets, often principally in silver and gold. The men who drove the hogs returned on foot, there being at that day no railroads or other cheap transportation for travelers. These with many other inconveniences, caused the whole of trade and commerce of our county to move very slowly indeed, in comparison with the state of affairs of the present day.

After the establishment of Marion county, and after the building of the courthouse, money being abundant, just subsequent to the establishment of banks in the State with an aggregate capital of \$18,000,000, the State had embarked in a large way in a system of internal improvements, and among other schemes it was determined to construct a turnpike road over Muldrough's Hill. In the year 1835, the State engineer, J. P. Boston, surveyed the different routes leading over the hill, and finally located the line of the present road, which under contract with the State was constructed by Joseph P.

I am working on the history of my husband's family and am looking for information on some of his ancestors who lived in Marion County, Kentucky, in the 1800's. His 3rd-great grandfather was George H. Gartin, who died in 1857. George Gartin's wife was Margaret Simpson. She was born about 1800 and was still alive at the time of the 1880 census. I have been told that Margaret Simpson was the daughter of John Simpson, one of the early settlers of Bradfordsville, and his wife, Mary McElroy, but I know very little about the Simpsons and the McElroys. I have seen a reference on page 146 of the Old Liberty Cemetery Book, published by the Bradfordsville Historical Society, that says that John Simpson and others, some named McElroy, met in 1789 and decided to build a Presbyterian church on Hardin Creek where later the Vaughn Hotel stood in Lebanon. Do you have any other references to John Simpson from the early days of the settlements of Bradfordsville or Lebanon?

Do you have any marriage, birth, or death records for Marion County that give any information about Margaret Simpson Gartin or her parents, John Simpson and Mary McElroy? Also, do you have a history of Marion County that might include information about the Gartin, Simpson, or McElroy families? If you do have a book with such information, I would appreciate a xerox copy of that information if it is possible to do easily, or information on whether it would be possible to borrow the book through our local public library.

Any information that you can send me would be helpful. I will be glad to pay a fee for xeroxing. I am enclosing a self-addressed, stamped envelope. Thank you.

A Prominent Citizen Passes Away.
Died At His Home Saturday
Night, June 11, '98.

A GOOD NEIGHBOR AND A FAITHFUL FRIEND.

On Sunday morning last our people were startled by the announcement of the death of Stephen H. Gartin, of the Bradfordsville district. He had been a sufferer for some time with heart trouble and his death at any time for many months might have been reasonably expected, and yet it came as a shock to all.

There were few men generally

known and more generally respected and loved than was S. H. Gartin. He was a truly representative citizen, a kind and loving husband, an affectionate and indulgent father, and a faithful friend. He was one of Marion county's most successful farmers and traders, and in his home was always glad to greet his friends with a cordiality and good cheer beyond description. Mr. Gartin was born May 7, 1831, and at the time of his death was sixty-seven years of age. He was married February 4, 1851, to Mrs. Nancy Thornton. Resulting from this marriage six children were born, all of whom survive him, but one, Mrs. Janie Dunn. The surviving members of his family are: Edna Head, George Gartin, Mrs. Mary Reynier, Henry T. Gartin and Mrs. Bettie Ozzatt, all of whom were with him at the time of his death. His wife preceded him to that home "beyond the stars" some several months, and was waiting for his coming. Their greeting in that "great beyond" will be a joyful one, and should be a solace and comfort to the sorrowing ones left behind, for their sufferings are over, their pains are all gone, and together they dwell in that beautiful city waiting your coming. Some time before his death he was admitted to membership in the Methodist church, and gave evidence to the fact that with him "all was well," that "death had lost its sting," and the grave could claim "no victory." The best evidence given of his popularity as a friend and citizen was the large concourse of relatives, friends and citizens who gathered at his funeral, which took place from his residence Monday, June 13. The exercises were conducted by Rev. J. L. Edrington, pastor of the Methodist church in this city, and were very impressive. After the funeral discourse his remains were carried to Old Liberty burial ground, and there placed at rest beside those of his wife. The remains were followed by the largest procession ever seen in this county. Like with the spirit of the immortal spirit in life, enjoying the sweet and beautiful of Heaven. Our sincerest sympathy is given to the sorrowing and bereaved ones. May they be comforted in the knowledge that their loss is his gain for through all the cycles of eternity he is at Rest.
