Their daughter, Ellen Thrift (1840-1924) married, in Breckinridge Co., Kentucky, Charles Sebastian (1824-81), son of Elizabeth Murray (1805-86) and Dr. Charles Sebastian (1790-1821; son of Benjamin Sebastian), who are both buried in Old Murray Cemetery, Cloverport, Ky.
