John Greenwell was born near Durham, England in 1625. He came to Maryland as an indentured servant to Edward Hall, probably served 7 yrs and was free when 18 yrs old. He married and acquired land which was purchased from Pille and was referred to as "Pileswoodland" or "Greenhill".

John was in the Newtown area of St. Mary's Co., in 1640. He was still in service in 1647 and in 1649 he received a registered brand for his cattle.

It appears he married in 1650 and had a son in 1650-1651. His first wife died-probably in child birth or shortly thereafter. John sent to England for a new wife which he received credit for transporting to the colony. He had no further issue and died in 1658. He was a farmer and a Catholic.

Will of John Greenwell of Newtowne, Md.-March 27, 1658-Apr. 1658; Liber PCR Folio 7. He willed to his son James, his entire estate, "Piles Woodland" and legacies to the following: his wife Bridget; a god-daughter Anna Warren; and Mr. Fitzherbert- to each personal items. His wife was to be in charge of the estate until his son became of age. Should he die during his minority, one third of the estate was to be bequeathed to overseers, Capt. Evans & James Longworth and the residue was to be disposed of to pious uses, as for the relief of poor Catholic children and the like.

John Greenwell, b ca 1625 possibly nr Durham, England (seat of the Greenwell family, & parents unknown), immigrated to America as an indentured servant to Edward Hall in 1640 & probably served seven years. (ref Prov Court St Mary's Co, Md LPR.F76 2/1/1642; LPR.F155 4/1/1644; LPR.F244 1647 & LPR.F276 1649). On Sept 29, 1649 John received "his marke for cattell & Hoggs Viz; The left Eare slitt & the right Eare a peice cut over and under". (MD Archives, Vol 1.279). He acquired land from John Piles in the Newtown area of St Mary's County, Md, referred to as "Piles Woodland" (or Greenhill), (today known as Compton), located on East side of Bretton Bay at the head of Knevets Creek in Newton Hundred.

The Newtown Mission was established bet 1638-1640. The Catholic Church was located on the Manor of Little Bretton, granted by Cecilius, Lord Baltimore, to William Bretton on Jul 10, 1640. Comprising some 850 acres of land in Newtown Hundred, it was the first settlement opened up after the Maryland had settled down at St Mary's City--a beautiful and rich neck of farm land reaching out into the Potomac River between Bretton Bay & St Clement's Bay in St Mary's County, Maryland. The Patuxent River separates St Mary's Co from Calvert Co.

John Greenwell m/1 ca 1650 to Mary Knowland, b ca 1626 England, who d soon after their only child, James, was born. John sent to England for his 2nd wife, Bridgett Seaborn, b ca 1626 and rec'd credit for transporting her to the Colony in 1654. (Prov Ct Rec S:1076). John was a planter & a Catholic. He d in 1658 (will dated 3/27/1658, will/probated 4/3/1658, Liber L:F7 Prov Land Off Court Recs, Annapolis. He willed his entire estate "Piles Woodland" to son, James, and legacies to wife Bridgett, a god-dau, Anna Warren, & Mr Fitzherbert ... his wife was to be in charge of thje estate until James became of age ... "should he die during his minority, 1/3 of the estate was to be bequeathed to overseers, Capt Evans & James Longworth & the rest to pius uses, as for the relief of poor Catholic Children & the like".

Letcher Co.'s First Hanging

Dear Editor:

Joyce Cook had a letter in the March, 1997, issue of the *Explorer* asking to know who the first man hanged in Letcher County was. I've already sent a copy to Ms. Cook, but I thought the other readers might be interested as well. It recalled to my mind the many times my mother told the story of the hanging of Floyd Frazier for the murder of Eleanor Flannery. The evidence indicated he covered her body with rocks when he attempted burying her at the head of Cowan Creek in Letcher County. I don't know who performed the hanging but assumed it was the sheriff of Letcher County at that time. I heard the evidence was circumstantial. They may have hanged the wrong man as Floyd was mentally deficient.

This all happened in 1912. It was the year my parents were married. I think this is all I know about the incident. People may be able to learn more about it if they contacted the Harry M. Caudill Memorial Library in Whitesburg. The library recently received a stack of old weekly issues of *The Mountain Eagle* printed during the tenure of Nehemiah Webb as editor. I think they may have been bound in book form by now. Webb was editor when my parents were married, and he wrote an article for the paper, a clipping of which my mother left following her death.

I think the mountain physician Ms. Cook mentioned was a man named Roark not Cornett. I never heard his given name. He was called Dr. Roark. He responded to families needing medical assistance for some member of the

family. Someone would go to Dr. Roark's abode on Carrs Fork by horseback to summon him. Over the years he responded to many calls for medical help to those living in a large portion on Letcher County. He served patients before there were trained physicians within 50 miles. Dr. Roark had no formal medical training. His knowledge came from old wives tales or by trial and error; some of which were better than nothing.

When Dr. Roark was sent for he came and stayed with a patient until he got better or died. The family of the patient provided bed and food. If an animal was present in the household his comment would be, "That dog (or cat) looks just like so and so," indicating someone he knew.

I don't think Dr. Roark held any kind of office. Ms. Cook mentioned Cornett was a mountain physician and had possibly been a judge. Roark was just a practicing mountain doctor who attended the sick and those needing

medical help.

Many years ago, before the turn of the century, Alamander Whitaker needed help when a log rolled over his leg and broke some bones. He had been cutting some virgin timber on his land when the accident happened. I do not know for sure that Dr. Roark attended Alamander. If he did he was not very good at repairing bone fractures. Alamander eventually got well but he had a severe limp that lasted all of his life.

Mason Whitaker (a relative) had a similar accident some time later. They cut off his right leg below the knee. He wore a peg leg the rest of his life. Who severed the leg? I don't know. I suppose he took a lesson from Alamander and decided he didn't want that kind of limp. His peg leg wasn't much better than a severe limp. Both men have long since passed on.

Fee, and Cassius Marcellus Clay. I was extremely interested in the story concerning the disagreement between Fee and Clay and how Clay, being afraid that his continued support of Fee was not the best for his political standing, withdrew his backing and protection. Kentucky being a state that had many slaves didn't accept his abolitionist ideas and exiled Fee and several families. Fee and these families returned to Cincinnati where Fee had lived before. I know there is a short list that Clay had made note of but I believe I read there were 50-60 families. I would be interested if anyone has any further knowledge of this story and if there is a list of who may have been exiled. I would appreciate any information.



Hull

In 1815 Samuel Edwin and Henry S. Hull left England for America and were shipwrecked off Cape Hatteras. Henry S. swam ashore to the coast of North Carolina, settled in Halifax County, and married a Miss Webb, of Scotland Neck, in 1817. In 1847 or 1848 a Samuel Hull, merchant in New York City, had a son named Henry S. In 1850 it was told that this Samuel Hull was dead, and the administrator was advertising for relatives. Their mother was a Sealy.

Daviess

Col. Joseph Hamilton Daviess was born in Bedford County, Virginia,

March 4, 1774. He came to Kentucky with his parents, Joseph and Jean Daviess, in 1779, and settled near Danville. He possessed a fine mind and was a close student. In 1794 he volunteered under Major Adair and served against the Indians, distinguishing himself for his valiant conduct. He was admitted to the bar in 1795 and was the first western lawyer who ever appeared in the Supreme Court of the United States. In 1805 Joseph arrayed Annie Marshall, sister of the chief justice. In 1806 his celebrated prosecution of Aaron Burr occurred, in which he confronted Henry Clay and John Allen. Joseph moved to Lexington in 1809. In 1811 he volunteered in the Indian War and was appointed major of the cavalry, but he was killed at the Battle of Tippecanoe, when he was fighting on foot in a charge made at his own request. He was a man of fine personal appearance and impression bearing. Joseph

was an able lawyer and a superior orator. His will was made July 18, 1811, and probated in the December court, 1811. He left no children, but a large estate to be divided into three parts, and then given to his three most promising nephews; these to be chosen by his executors.

Davenport

Daniel Davenport was reared in Clark County, Kentucky. He removed to Lee County, Virginia, and he married Rebecca Grubbs Jones. His father's name was Stephen Davenport. His brother, John Davenport, was in the War of 1812 with General John Poage. Rebecca was the daughter of Wylie Jones and Mary Dickinson Jones. Mary Dickinson was also married to a Hamlin. Mary's father was Daniel Dickinson, who went to Lee County, Virginia, from Botetourt County, Virginia.

Three brothers battle same heart disease

Editor's note: The Greenwell brothers are formerly of Madison County.

I was skeptical about Doug Greenwell's claim that at 32 he has a badly damaged heart.

It's another blow to learn that two of the Bardowyn man's older brothers are in the same boat.

Now Ron Greenwell, 36, and Keith Greenwell, 34, have both been diagnosed with cardiomyopathy. It means they have dangerously enlarged, defective hearts that constantly get weaker.

It's a mystery to the Greenwells. "We've all spent a great deal of our adult lives," said Ron, "whose heart pumps so poorly that he wheezes for breath when he talks. This was a shock."

First Doug was diagnosed with the disease this summer after the otherwise healthy diesel mechanic faced spells of weakness, breathing problems and a fluid buildup that made him feel like massive pressure was crushing his chest.

Doug's heart is so weak that doctors have given him a year to live if no donor heart is found.

Now Ron and Keith are looking down the tunnel.
Doug's heart is a whole lot weaker, Ron said. "But I'm on the same road."
After being diagnosed the brothers realized that their father, who died at

45, also had cardiomyopathy, although at the time "we were fit—we just thought he died of a heart attack."

The doctor who dug through Earl Greenwell's medical records from the time of his death in 1978 has confirmed, however, that the father and his sons have been hit with an inherited heart problem.

Earl Greenwell had five sons. Two of those brothers still have not shown symptoms of the disease and have not yet had their hearts checked, Ron said.
Now Ron worries about the

Doug wears a respirator that so he can be notified when minutes at Jewish Hospital in Louisville for care, a donor heart.

As of December, Ron has been forced to quit work to keep from further damaging his weakened heart.
Soon Keith will also have to call himself totally disabled.

Bill collectors call your house all the time," Doug said. "At first I worried myself sick about it. I never made a late payment in my life."

Now, however, "I tell them I have a terminal disease, and I send them what I can."
The brothers have puzzled for hours, trying to figure out why they were diagnosed with the disease within the last five months.

"We wonder if it could have been all of us catching the same coughing virus, or something in the water we're drinking," Doug said. "It blows our minds."
The youngest brother hopes to hold on until he gets a transplant. If his heart weakens much more, he faces a tough decision.

"The only thing they can do is put me on a machine that will pump my blood for me—but the doctors say, if infection sets up, I'm a goner."
Doug is grateful his brother's disease was diagnosed at an earlier stage than his was.

"If they slow down now, they probably can prolong their lives."




