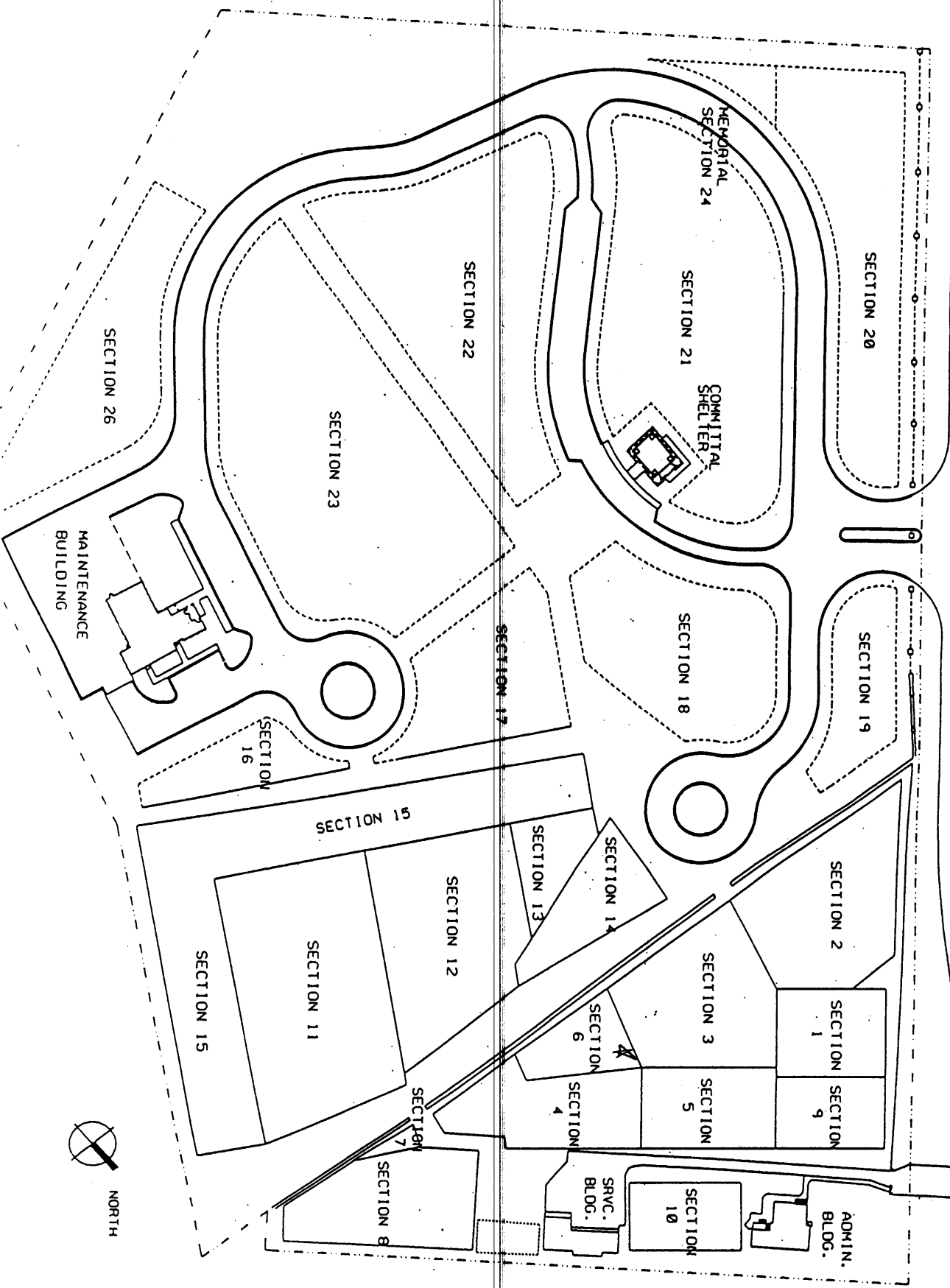

A.J. Harris, Mount Sinai trustee, ex-president of Jewish federation

A.J. Harris, past president of the Greater Miami Jewish Federation and a life trustee of Mount Sinai Medical Center, died Thursday at the Miami Beach hospital. He was 88.

"He gave of his time and his money quite generously," said Mr. Harris' son, Marvin.

Also a member of the board of directors, Mr. Harris served as president of the Jewish federation from 1961 to 1962. During his term, the Jewish Community Foundation for Legacies and Bequests was established.

His tenure at Mount Sinai spanned 30 years. Mr. Harris joined the hospital's board of trustees in 1957 and served as the organization's treasurer, secretary and vice president before being named a life trustee in 1970. The honor came as recognition of his years of dedication to the board.

Once a Kentucky distiller, Mr. Harris moved to Miami in 1947 to enjoy the fine weather and fine fishing. He had the idea of going into semi-retire-



ment, but he couldn't sit still and "it didn't work out," his son said.

Instead of taking leisure time, Mr. Harris went to work, opening the Midwest Mortgage Co. He built his resources to the point where he could acquire controlling interest in the Metropolitan Bank of Miami and the Everglades Bank in Fort Lauderdale. He held onto the banks a few years, his son said, then opened the Bank of Dade County in North Dade, retiring several years ago.

Born in St. Louis, Mr. Harris did well enough in real estate during the early years of the Depression to buy the John A. Wathen distillery in Louisville right after Prohibition ended. The maker of Kentucky sour mash bourbon, John A. Wathen grew to be the largest independent distillery in Kentucky, Marvin Harris said. Mr. Harris sold the company just prior to World War II.

In addition to Marvin, survivors include his wife, May; two other sons, L.J. and David; one daughter, Rosemary Green; and 11 grandchildren.

Services will be at 1:30 p.m. today at the Riverside Alton Road Chapel. Interment will follow at Graceland Memorial Park.
