FRANKLIN HAZELWOOD: Indisputable evidence proves the he was born about 1820. In Washington County, Ky. and died in or soon after 1872, evidence shows in Harding County, KY. We know that he married Lucinda Brown the daughter of Chaffin Brown and Jane Linch. They were married in Mercer Co., KY. February 12, 1844 By Rev, S. Hatch. Longtime Hazelwood family friend, William Ramsey made oath that Lucinda Brown was 21 yrs old, and that she lived in Mercer Co. Franklin marriage certificate stated he was born in Washington Co, Ky. Eight children were born to Franklin and Lucinda. Lucinda was named after her mothers sister, Lucinda O'Daniel. A daughter of the Hazelwoods, Chinisa, birth certificate states that her father Franklin, was born in Washington Co, Ky. 1820.

We can not find Franklin or Lucinda in Trimble Co. after 1868. But we find Marion in Larue Co. in 1869.

RICHARD D. HAZELWOOD
(1784-ca-1854)

Richard Hazelwood; was born in 1783/4. (some evidence tend's to prove Warren Co, N.C.) no Hazelwood's can be found in Washington County, Kentucky before 1813. Richard spent most of his adult life in Washington County and I think that the record in Washington County has a tendency to prove that Franklin was one of the many son's of Richard.

Washington County, Ky. was formed in 1792, the first-born of the new state of Kentucky, the previous nine having been established by Virginia. It was very properly named in honor of Virginia's greatest and best citizen, the then U.S. President, General George Washington; and was formed out of that part of the county of Nelson including within the following bounds:

"Beginning on Salt river where the boundary line between Nelson and Mercer crosses the same; thence down the same river to the mouth of Crooked creek, or what is called by some Lewis' run; thence a straight line to the mouth of Beaver creek, a brance of Chapline's fork; and thence down Chapline's fork to the Beech Fork; thence down the Beech fork to the mouth of Hardin's creek; thence a straight line to the Big Knob lick, near the head of Pottinger's creek; thence a straight line to the mouth of salt Lick run, emptying into the Rolling Fork on the south side'; thence up the main branch of said run to the ridge dividing the waters of the Rolling Fork from Green river waters; thence eastwardly along the said dividing ridge to the line dividing Lincoln from Nelson; thence with the same to the Mercer line; thence along the line between Nelson and Mercer to the beginning."

From this territory were taken part of Anderson in 1827, and the whole of Marion in 1834. Washington County is situated near the center of the state, and drained by Salt river; it is bounded N. by Anderson Co, E. by Mercer and Boyle, S. and W. by Marion, and N.W. by Nelson. (The above taken from Collins History of Kentucky, Vol 11.)

There are many discrepancies in dates and spelling, and the duplication of residence on census records makes research very difficult.

From 1834 through 1839 we can not find Richard. but we do
find him in 1840, in Marion Co., KY. and according to the Syndex
listing for Kentucky, there were only two Richards in KY, in
1840; one in Green Co., and one in Marion, and I know that the
one in Green Co, is not the Richard above. Marion became a
County January 25, 1834. Was named after Gen. Francis Marion the
"Swamp Fox" of the Revolutionary War. County seat is Lebanon.

In 1862, Civil War solders burnt the Marion County court house
to the ground destroying all county records from 1834 through 1862.

In 1823, The Washington Co. Tax Book. Page 31, shows that
Richard owns 50 acres of land which lays in Larue Co. and the
water course is in Larue Co. (Larue did not become a county
untill 1843). Now Larue extends a long finger Eastwards into
Marion Co. And long before Larue became a county, it was refered
to as larue country, this could explain the descrepancy, as to
why Larue was refered to as Larue Co. before it became a County.
