This day Joseph Pike, adm of Henry H Shively decd produced in court a written statement of the price for which he sold a Negro child towit \$175 & \$11.18 collected in open accounts which said statement as return is ordered to record.

A settlement with the administrators of the estate of Henry H Shively decd was this day produced in court which together with the several vouchers therein was ordered to be entered of record the same having laid in the clerks office of this county for one month previous to this day.

Meade County, Kentucky Court Order Book D, P 89 -1844  
On motion of Elizabeth Shively widow of Henry H Shively decd it is ordered that she be and is hereby appointed guardian to Jno H Shively, Anzerelia Shively, James W Shively, Emaline Shively, Julian Shively, and Thomas R Shively infant heirs of the said H H Shively decd. Such of said infants as are fourteen years of age having made choices of the said Elizabeth Shively and thereupon she the said Elizabeth together with Thomas Heavrin and Maxfield Willett her securities executed bond in the penalty of \$3000 payable to the Commonwealth conditioned as the law directs.

Meade County, Kentucky Court Order Book D, P 178 1-December-1845  
A settlement made by the County Commissioners with Joseph Pike adm of the estate of Henry H Shively decd was this day produced in court and ordered to record the same having remained on deposit in the clerks office one month for exceptions as required by law.

On motion of Franklin Cunningham it is ordered that Thomas J Gough one of the examiners of this county have leave to withdraw Voucher No filed by Joseph Pike in a settlement made by him as adm of H H Shivelys estate being a note given by said Shively to John Stephenson for the purpose of having the same proven by deposition in the chancery suit in the Meade Circuit Court in the name of said Cunningham against Jas W Shively decd said note or voucher to be returned to the said Gough at the next \_\_\_\_\_ or July term of this court thereupon the same was withdrawn.


