FOR NATIVE AND NATURALIZED CITIZENS

All American citizens who have resided abroad for many years, because of the manner of the postwar legislation for naturalization, are in a peculiar position. They are citizens of the United States, but often have been unable to obtain the United States passport for traveling abroad. On August 19, 1946, the United States government announced that it would issue passports to citizens who had been abroad for more than 10 years, and who had not been able to obtain a passport for the last 10 years. This was a very important step, as it allowed these citizens to travel abroad and return to the United States without having to go through the naturalization process again.
