OPINION OF OFFICER TAKING AFFIDAVIT.

(The officer who takes the affidavit should state definitely below whether, in his opinion, the affiant has satisfactorily explained his protracted foreign residence or is in a position to overcome the presumption of expatriation. In doing so he should consider first, whether the facts recited constitute the true cause of the foreign residence, and second, whether they are sufficient under the established rules to entitle him to protection as an American citizen. He should sign his name and add his title below the statement of his opinion.)

The applicant stated that on account of not having sufficient money it has been impossible for him to return to the United States before, and that he has been compelled to reside abroad in order to exercise his profession of bicycle racing. He added that since the sport has been resumed in the United States he expects to be able to return there.

I am of the opinion that he has stated the true cause of his protracted foreign residence and that he is entitled to protection as an American citizen.
