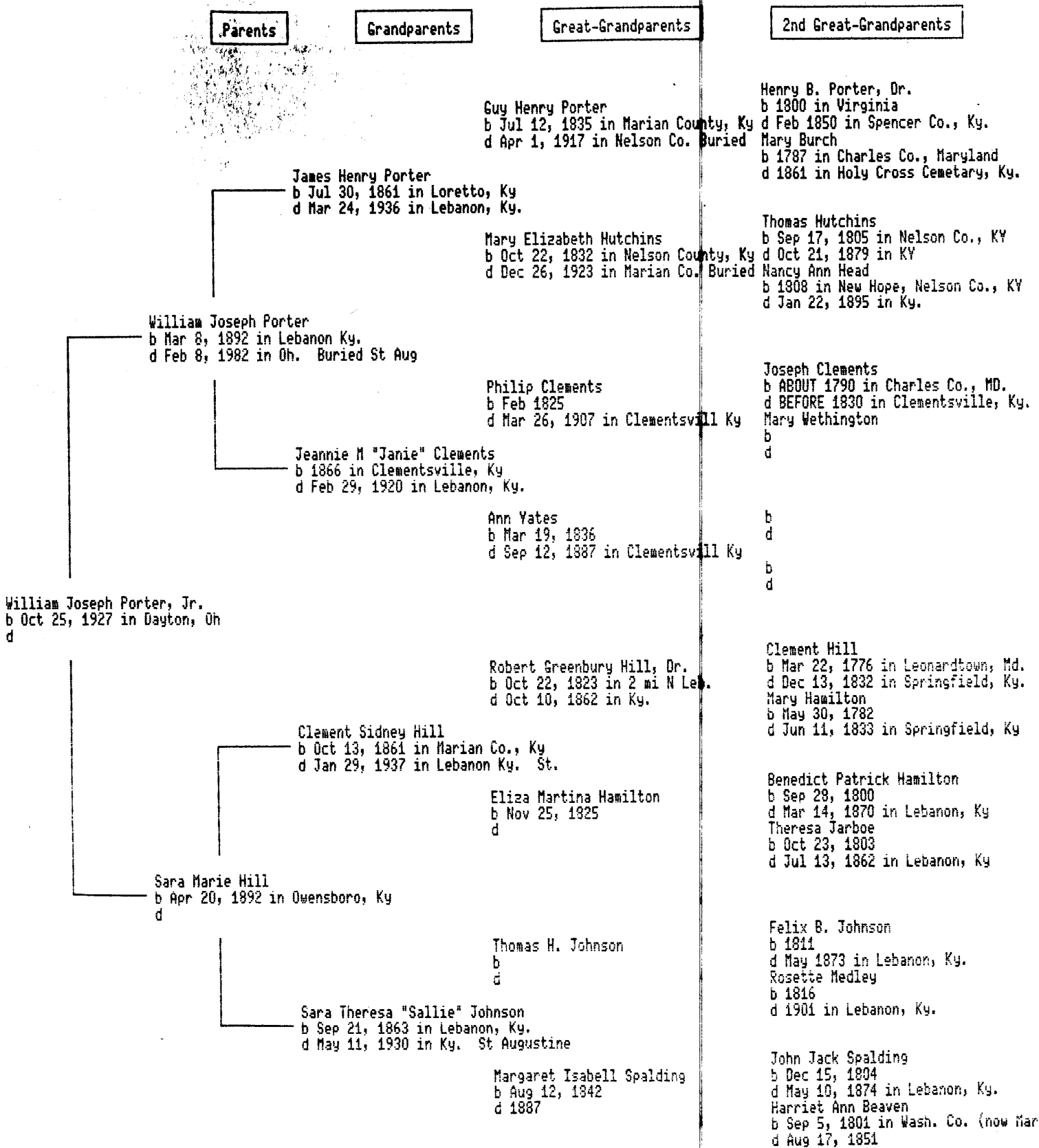

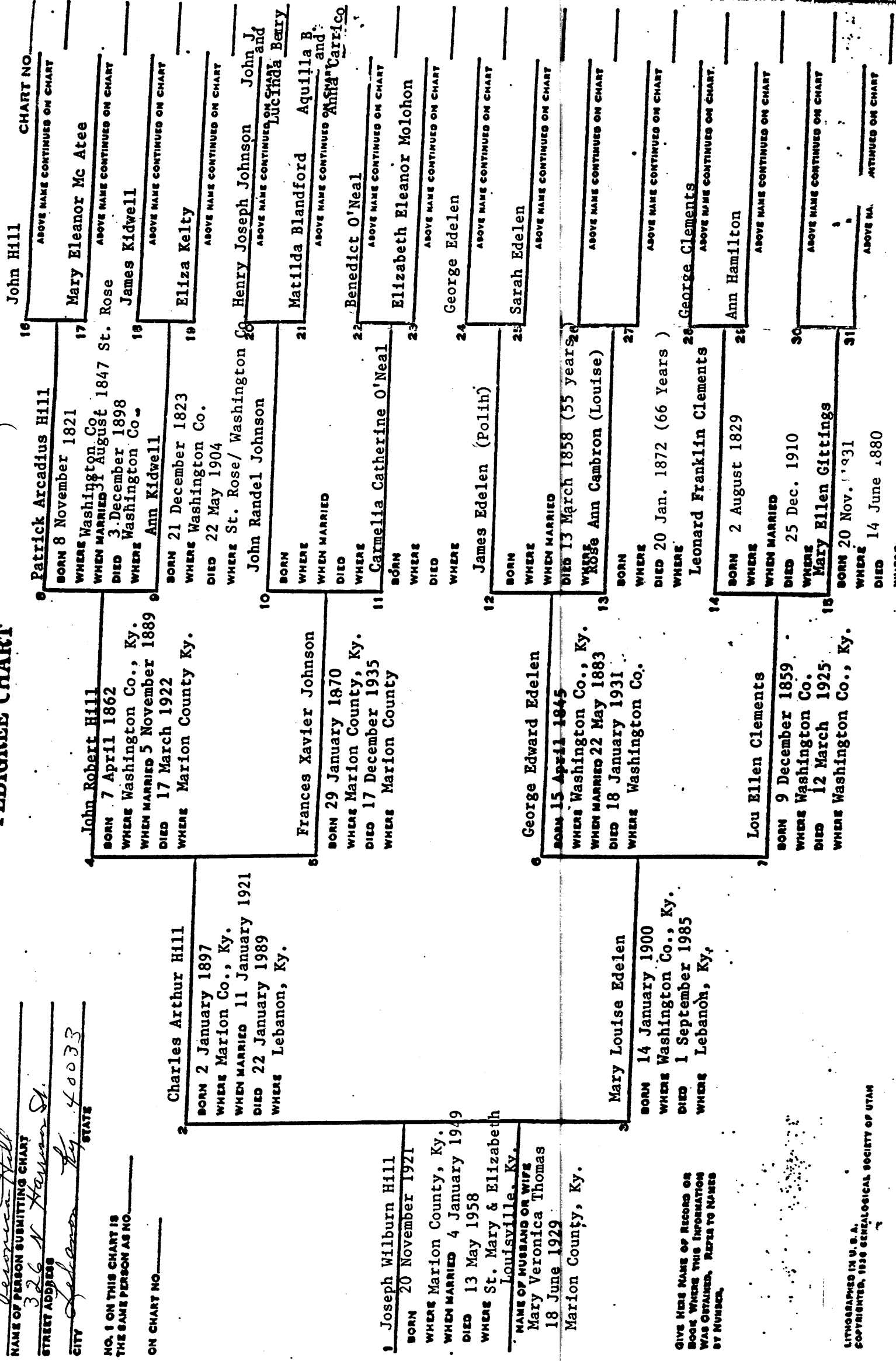

Thank you so much for responding to my query in KY Ancestors. As you have expressed interest, I am enclosing a family tree of my ancestors which includes Dr. Henry B. Porter. Since the query, it has been discovered that Dr. Henry's father was Philip Porter, born about 1750 and his mother was Nancy "Ann" Porter. They immigrated from Virginia to Shelby Co. in 1811. Nancy Ann died there in January, 1850, two months before Dr. Henry did.

As you can see from the family tree, all of my ancestors for four generations were Kentuckians with my Gr. Gr. Grandparents being early settlers of that state. My mother, who is 101 years old, and my father were from Marian Co. My Aunt, Mrs. Grace Beaven still lives there; My Uncle, Dr. Joe Hill just passed away this last August. Some of my fondest memories are the visits to Lebanon to visit my Grandparents and relatives in the 30's and 40's.

I will be in Lebanon about Oct. 12th or 13th to for my semi-annual visit to my Aunts and cousins. At that time I hope to visit the genealogy dept. at the Lebanon Library.

Again, I appreciate your interest and your letter. With the enclosed information, if there is any data that the Marian County Historical Society has in their files that would be applicable, that information would be greatly appreciated.

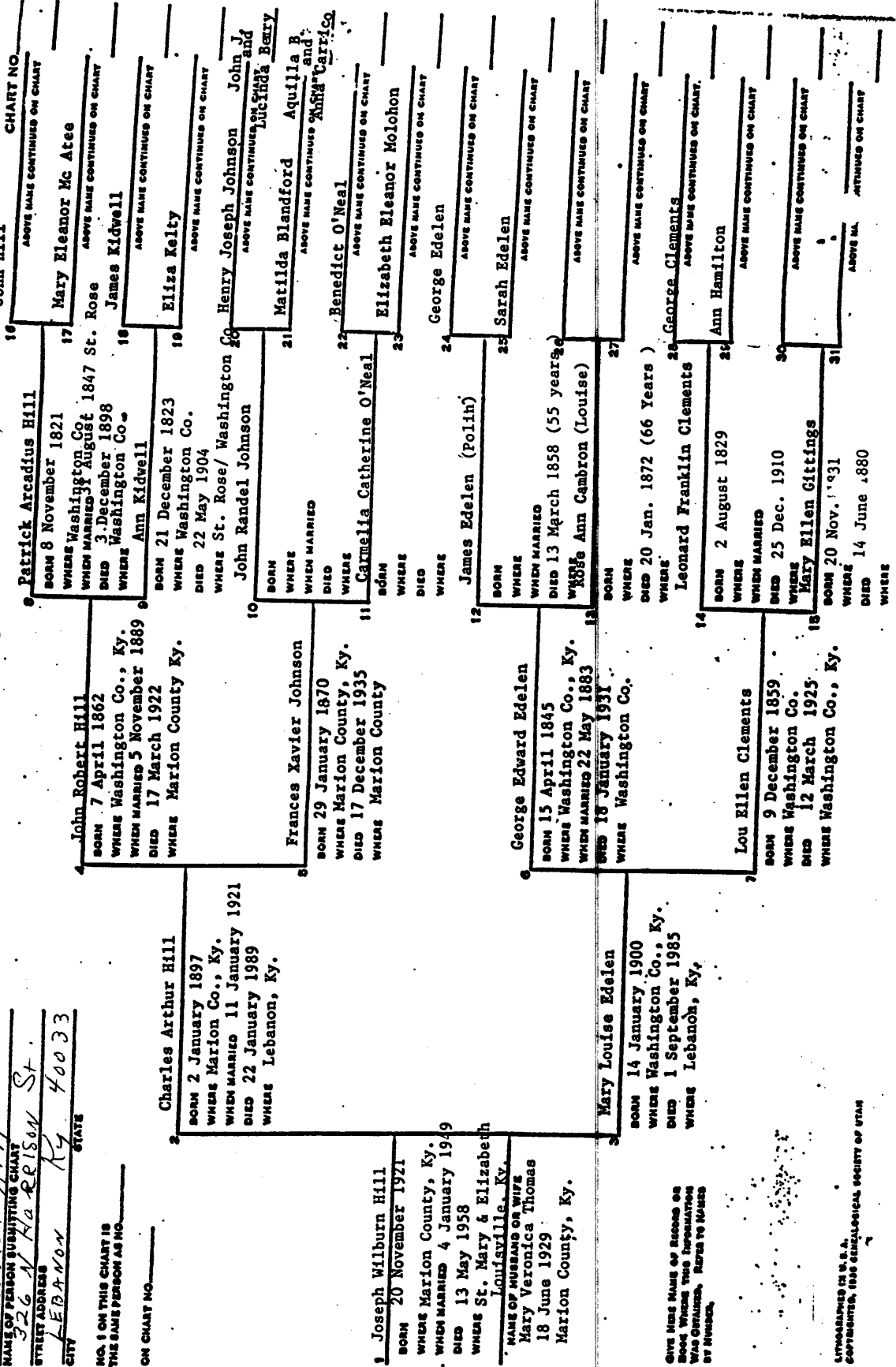

I enjoyed our chat at the Kentucky Historical Society, just before your "big storm" of January 16-18. Luckily, I flew home before the storm.

Enclosed is my material on Clem Hill's ancestors. His family is on Family Group Record 88; his father's family is on Family Group Record 41. Leo Hayden's Bible information is in Sister Donnelly's Rapier, Hayden book.

The enclosed list of Sister Donnelly's books came from a fellow Elderhostel student, living in Missouri. I passed your name on to this woman, so in time you may hear from her. Look for Clem Hill in Sister Donnelly's book on Thomas Hill and Rebecca Miles. Try her Imprints 1608-1980, Hamilton, Allied Families for Richard Hamilton Hill.

A 1990 book by A. Louise Shelton on the Greenwell and others has details on the Catholic families who migrated from Maryland to Kentucky to Missouri. This 800+ page book is not at the Kentucky Historical Society, but may be available in your area or in Louisville. Somewhere I've got Mrs. Shelton's address, but can't easily find it in the rat's nest of papers. A 1984 book on the Greenwells by Marion Elizabeth Greenwell Burgelin differs slightly from the Shelton book and is not as well documented.

Hope you've recovered from the winter and are deep into the January thaw. Our local saying is, "As the days lengthen, the cold strengthens." We're having a touch of January thaw, but the snow piles will hang on into March.

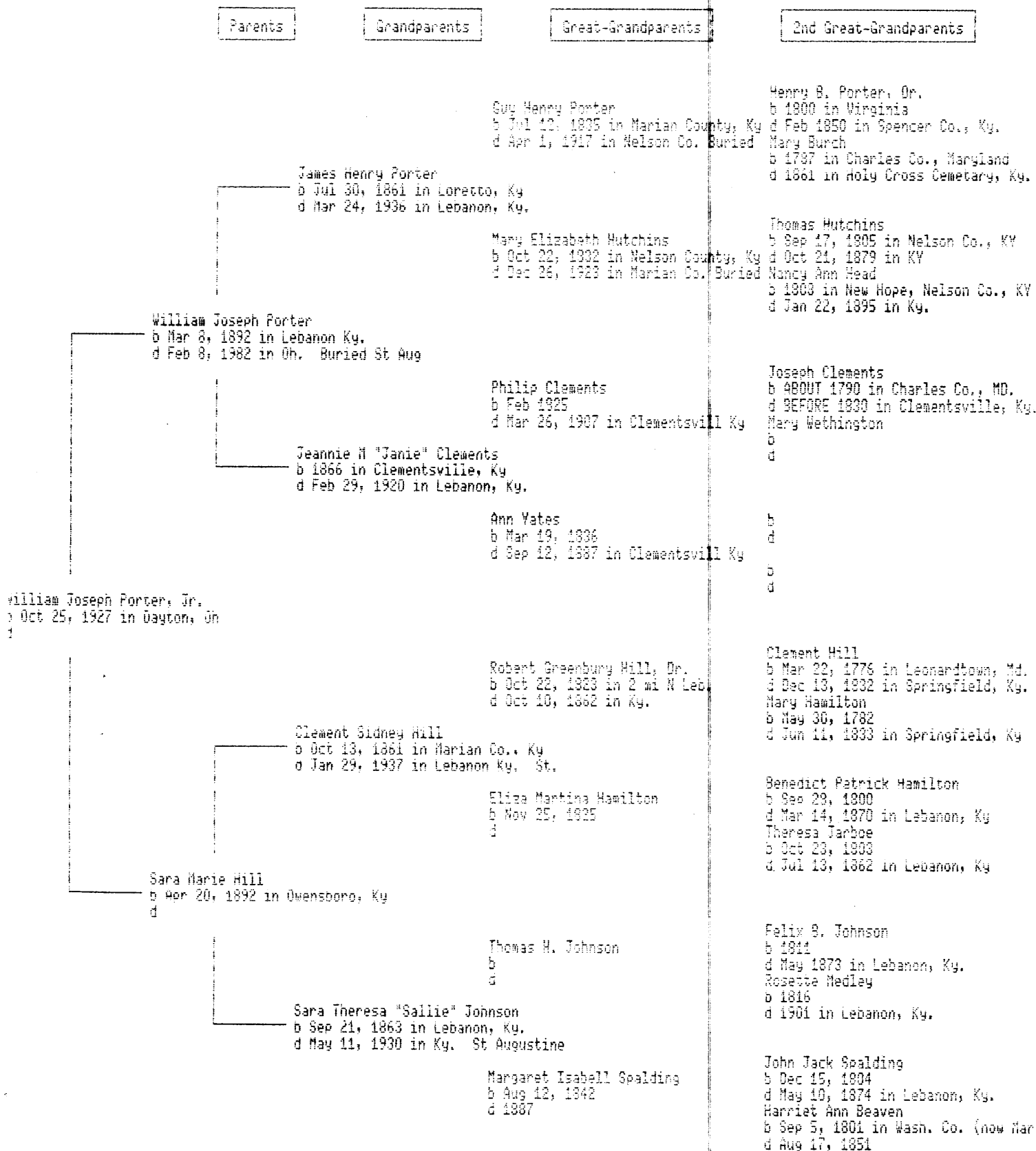

the few men who when elected to public office carry into the discharge of their duties the same energy and enthusiasm that characterize their attention to their private affairs. Most men who are elected to office by the people mean to do their duty; but they frequently perform it in a perfunctory manner and without that interest which is productive of the best results.

Not so with Mr. Hill. When he was honored with the office of County Attorney, he set about the accomplishment of certain things which he thought were conducive to the public interest, and the result of the labors of himself and his contemporaries in the management of county affairs is proof of the industry and sound judgment that has been displayed. When Mr. Hill came into office the county owed \$24,000, turnpike matters were in an unsettled state, and it was the custom of holders of claims against the county to be compelled to wait a year after they were allowed before they could be paid. The present administration at once turned its attention to retrenchment in public affairs, with the result that the expenses of

Clem S. Hill was born in Marion

county, October 13, 1862. He was edu-

cated at Cecilian College, in Hardin

county, and on leaving college entered

the office of his brother, R. G. Hill,

then Circuit Clerk of the county, per-

forming the duties of deputy clerk for

some years, and at the same time

studying law. He was admitted to the

Lebanon bar, but shortly afterward

took charge of the Lebanon Enter-

prise, which he edited and managed

with marked success for about two

and a half years. The Enterprise was

sold in 1891, and Mr. Hill removed to

Owensboro, engaging in the practice

of law, and he remained in that city

six years. While he met with reason-

able success, like all who have left

Lebanon, he had a hankering to come

back, and in 1897 he did return and

resumed the practice of law at this

bar. In November, 1901, he was

elected to the office of County Attor-

ney, and his record in this position we

have briefly outlined in the foregoing.

He has a fine law practice, which is

steadily increasing.

Mr. Hill was married February 11,

1885, to Miss Sallie Johnson, of

this county. He has Rooseveltian

ideas on some subjects, as demon-

strated by the fact that his home is

blessed with ten children—three boys

and seven girls.
