I did not find any Hovins - Hovious - Hovis other than the one enclosed on any of our cemetery or marriage records. Of course marriage records for Marion County prior 1863 were destroyed by fire. The Court House was burned during the Civil War. We do not have the 1840 Census of Marion County in book form, we do have it on micro film, but our staff is quite small and there was not enough available time to search.

I will keep your name and address on file and in the future if anything turns up on the name Hovins I will let you know.
