Get your letter today. I have seen your work in the library. I am pleased to share what I have with you and hope that it is helpful.

The Wilhelmina Myers who married John Glasscock is not of my direct line but is the line of Harold Glasscock who married Elizabeth Hendley. Elizabeth now has Atzingers and Harold (his nickname is Sam) has his hands full. Of course Harold's line and mine do merge. John Glasscock who married Wilhelmina Myers was the son of James Wm Glasscock who married Christina Pennington. James Wm was the son of Chafin Glasscock who 1st married Lucinda Nash and 2nd married Susan Catlin Hagen. There were no children by the second marriage. Chafin was a brother to Elijah Glasscock who married Margaret Hays. I descend from Elijah & Margaret. Chafin was 12 years younger than Elijah. They were the only sons of Wharton and Nancy (Minnie) Chaffin Glasscock. They had 5 sisters: Kezia married Wm Milburn, Lucinda married Richard Skinner, Polly married George Webb, Elizabeth married David McKinley and Mary C. married J. H. Howard.

Speculation and at this point purely speculation. ~~Kezia~~ Mary C. was a 1st cousin to J. H. Howard. His mother was presumably a sister to Nancy (Minnie) Glasscock.

What I have on Williamina + John is as follows.
 I have her date of birth as 19 Oct 1858 - Don't know
 where I got this. Surg. Date of marriage 16 Nov 1880
 and death date 30-12-1934. John's full name
 was John Gordon or Gordon (I have seen
 it spelled both ways) 507 B 20 Sept 1858, date of
 death 14-Jan 1940. Both are buried in the Glasgow
 Cemetery. On her death certificate (Marion
 County Health Dept.) it lists her father Fred Myers
 a native of Denmark, it also states that Williamina
 died of leukemia. John died from a heart attack.

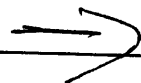

County, Kentucky 1810 census and later in the 1840 census for Graves County, Kentucky.
The last record that I have about Edmond Inman is he is listed in the B.B. of his
daughter; Elizabeth and husband Iasiah Collez, 1860 Graves County, Kentucky.

The birth place for Golden maybe Washington County, Kentucky and he married a cousin;
Polly (or a widow). Research of Washington County, Kentucky may help here.

Other Inman hunters believe that the surname Inman/Inrman is as common as the name
Smith in Tennessee/Kentucky. Also that Inman is closely associate with Hirman, the
two have the same arms, crest and motto. Hirman is of ancient Saxon or German in
origin. The name Inman is recorded before 1600 in Bowthwaite Grange, Netherdale and
County York, England. Some of the first Inman immigrate to America & settled in
Rhode Island.

My Elizabeth Ann Inman Acup is somewhere in all ^{these} Inman families.

Dear Mary,

Mr Jim Williams of Temple, Texas informed me that you are doing some research on the Inman name, in Washington County, Ky. hopefully, you may have information that I need.

I've been able to trace my branch of the Inman name back as far as a certain Golden Inman who supposedly married Polly (maiden name unknown) on 7 December 1830 in Washington County Ky. This marriage is supposed to be listed in "marriage book #2, page 246", according to one source.

Golden apparently moved west to Calloway Co., Ky., within the first decade of his marriage, because he shows up there in the 1840 Calloway County census.

His next move must have been to Graves Co., Ky., because he shows up on the Graves County Tax List for the years 1841, 1842, 1843 & 1844.

One of his Sons, My Great-Grandfather, Andrew Jackson Inman, was born there in Graves County, Ky., in about 1840.

Shortly after that, (around 1846 or 1848) Golden, Polly and their children moved to South-East Missouri, in Butler County. The Children of Golden & Polly were as follows:

Missouri census data indicates that Golden was Born in 1805. LDS Family History records shows that he was born in 1814.

I would surely like to know the names of his Father and Grandfather.

One lead shows that there was a certain Edmond G. Inman, born about 1782 in Virginia; listed on the 1840 Graves County 1840 census.

He is said to be listed again in Graves County in the H.H. of his daughter Elizabeth and her husband, Isaiah Collez in 1860.

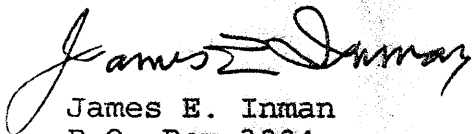
It seems likely, although by no means certain, that Edmond G. Inman might be the father of Golden Inman for three reasons:

INMANS

Sometimes you find information in the most unusual places. In an old book store in Frankfort, I came across a book, "On This Foundation", written by William J. Castleman. His name caught my eye because of Castleman's Run. It is located in Marion County in behind and between Cartwright's Creek and Pleasant Run. So out of curiosity I opened the book to discover it was a biography of Samuel Guy Inman. This brief biography published in 1966, is only 176 pages, but the two page prologue contained some remarkable information.

"Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego Inman sailed west from England around 1765. After landing on the Virginia coast, they settled for a while at Limestone. Going on farther west they became involved in a number of Indian skirmishes. While on their way from Kentucky to North Carolina with Daniel Boone, Meshach was killed by Indians. Later on both remaining brother were wounded, Shadrach was struck by an Indian spear or arrow. Abednego received a tomahawk blow on the head.

The Inman brothers fought for freedom on the side of the colonist during the American Revolution. Shadrach was a Captain and Abednego was a Major. When the war for independence had been won, Abednego helped to establish and incorporate Tennessee in the Union in 1796. Later, he was appointed Magistrate of the first court held in Dandridge. Abednego Inman was wed t Mary Ritchie in Limestone, Virginia, in 1778. One of their eleven children was William Hardin Inman. One of William's sons was Benjamin Richardson Inman.

For a while Benjamin lived in Cleveland, Tennessee, where he operated an inn with his brother, James Wilson Inman, Benjamin married Ann Carson. They had seven children, Joel, one of their sons, was born in Dandridge, Tennessee in 1847. Benjamin's wife and three of their children died in Cleveland. After their deaths he decided to take the remaining members of his family farther west. With his three sons, Samuel, James and Joel, and one daughter the sixteen year old Elizabeth, Benjamin Inman made the rugged and hazardous journey to Texas in covered wagons. Three days after they settled in Crockett, Elizabeth died. In the War between the States Samuel went into the Confederate army and was killed. James married and settled in Groveton, the county seta of Trinity County. Joel Inman also settled in Trinity. He met and married Caroline Rodgers. They were wed on Christmas Day in 1872. They set up their home together on Trinity River farm."

Got your letter today. I have seen your work in the library. I am pleased to share what I have with you and hope that it is helpful.

The Wilhelmina Myers who married John Glasscock is not of my direct line but is the line of Harold Glasscock who married Elizabeth Hendley. Elizabeth now has Altzimmers and Harold (his nickname is Sam) has his hands full. Of course Harold's line and mine do merge. John Glasscock who married Wilhelmina Myers was the son of James Wm Glasscock who married Christina Pennington. James Wm was the son of Chaffin Glasscock who 1st married Lucinda Nash and 2nd married Susan Catlin Hagen. There were no children by the second marriage. Chaffin was a brother to Elijah Glasscock who married Margaret Spay. I descend from Elijah & Margaret. Chaffin was 12 years younger than Elijah. They were the only sons of Wharton and Nancy (Minnie) Chaffin Glasscock. They had 5 sisters: Keziah married Wm Milburn, Lucinda married Richard Skinner, Polly married George Webb, Elizabeth married David McKinley and Mary C. married G. H. Howard.

Speculation and at this point purely speculation ~~that~~ Mary C. was a 1st cousin to G. H. Howard. His mother was presumably a sister to Nancy (Minnie) Glasscock.

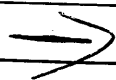

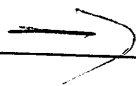
