John Ellis (born 29 Jan. 1749, in Spotsylvania Co., Virginia) and his wife, Sarah Parrish (Parish) (born 20 Apr. 1751, probably in Spotsylvania Co., Va.) died near Lexington, Kentucky, within two weeks of each other in 1794 (he on 15 Jan. and she on 1 Feb.). John died intestate, atypical of this family, which indicates a sudden, unexpected demise. Seek information regarding the circumstances of the deaths of John and Sarah Ellis. Any theories will be welcome (natural catastrophe?; Indian skirmish?; pure coincidence?).
