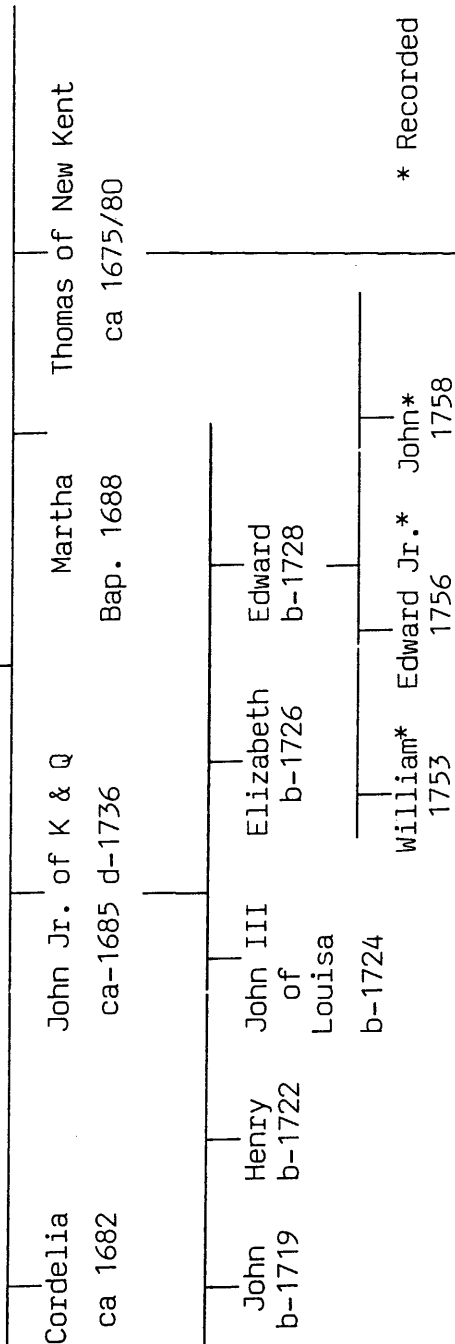

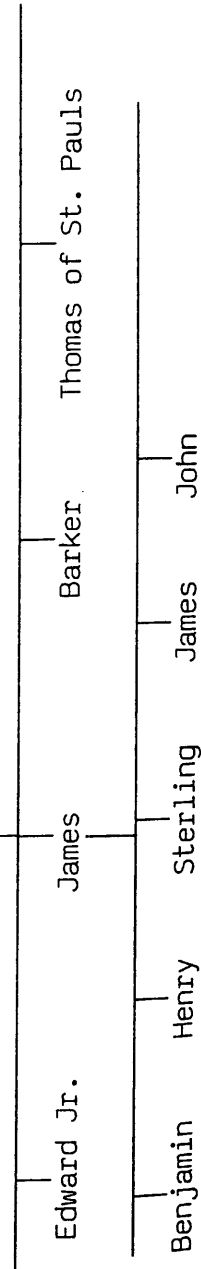
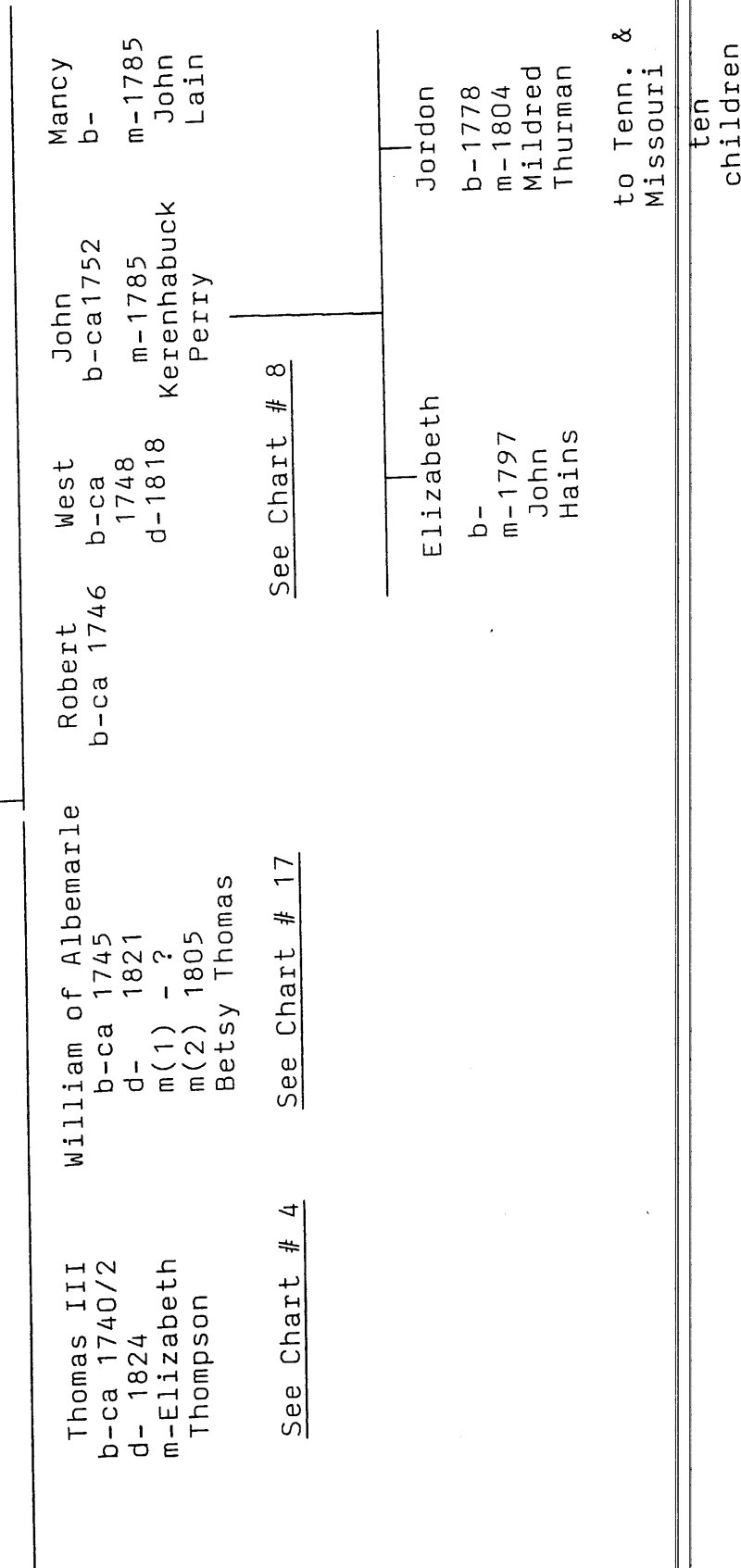

THOMAS - now LANGFORD - OF LOUISA



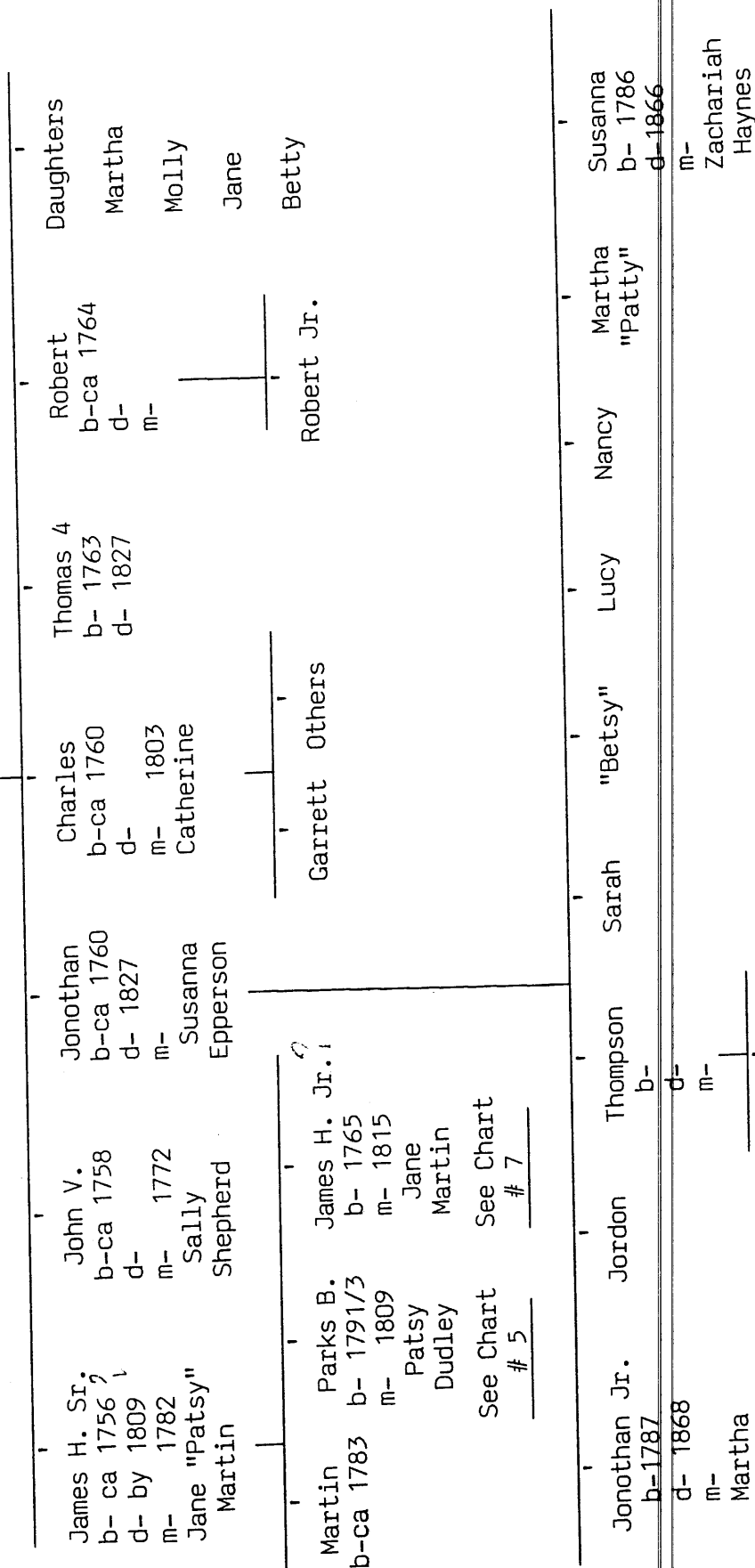
