### Death Takes Young Man.

Roy Lay, 21 years old, died Wednesday morning at 5:10 o'clock at the home of his sister, Mrs. Thomas Williams, on the St. Rose Pike, about three and a half miles from town. Death was due to tuberculosis and followed a long illness.

The young man was born in this county March 5, 1902, a son of Richard and Sue Lay, deceased. He was a member of the Catholic Church. Surviving him are a brother, James Lay, and four sisters, Mrs. Williams, Mrs. Tom Wright, Mrs. Reuben Goode and Miss Grace Lay, all of this county.

Funeral services will be conducted this morning at 9:00 o'clock at St. Augustine's Church by the Rev. J. A. Hogarty. Burial will be in St. Augustine's Cemetery.

### Library Receives Grant.

A grant of \$5,000 to the Library Commission at Hodgenville for the Lincoln Memorial Public Library was approved a few days ago by the Civil Works Administration, and will be expended for labor on the erection of a library building. The commission recently purchased the Presbyterian Church building. This is to be razed, and the new building, which is to be of limestone, will be erected on the site. Materials for the building will be furnished by the commission. The library is a project of the Hodgenville Woman's Club.
