Leake's quest for knowledge continues with new rank

"Dad, I want to learn Karate."

That's how it all got started. A request from his 12-year-old son led Sherman Leake to seek out a dojo (a place of enlightenment; a place where Karate is taught). He'd heard about a dojo in Campbellsville and took his son there to watch a class. Leake was so intrigued by what he saw that the 41-year-old joined himself along side his son.

Two classes a week for the next three and a half year and Leake was promoted to the rank of Sho Dan, a First Degree Black Belt in Okinawan Shorin-Ryu Karate. "The night I got promoted I felt good about my performance," he reflected, "but I had only learned enough to realize how little I knew."

He never stopped being a student. With that came the desire to show others what he had learned and through teaching he continued to improve his knowledge and ability.

In late 1984, Leake opened his own dojo in Lebanon and taught for two years in a recreation room behind the Lebanon Florist nursery.

"Teaching Karate is a world apart

time non-aggressive, which fosters an environment of positive growth for each and every one of his students. His dedication and hard work to his students has given... a positive role model for all to follow."

Even as Leake enjoyed the success of his dojo, he had to deal with the growing weight of unfortunate circumstances. He remained a First Degree Black Belt for eleven years as his peers were promoted to Second, Third and even Fourth Degrees.

Because the highest ranking practitioner of Shorin-Ryu in this area was a Second Degree, Leake had no chance to advance. There was also a growing concern among his Black Belt students who were beginning to realize they were at the same disadvantage.

"People didn't believe I was just a Sho Dan," Leake said. "I'd seen these guys around for years and eventually some of the bigger named people (who belonged to larger organizations and World Federations) offered to promote me."

But he declined those offers. Leake vowed to remain a Sho Dan until someone in his own system of Karate would recognize him as otherwise.

The dojo had reached an impasse and for the first time its solidarity was in question. Once again, Leake found himself searching for a dojo but this time he had to find one in Shorin-Ryu with a high ranking instructor.

An eight hour drive to Bastrop, Texas ended the search. This dojo, just outside of Dallas, was the home of a Seventh Degree. Dialog with this instructor began in 1984 and on May 1, 1995, Leake was promoted from a First Degree straight to a Fourth Degree. His effort to travel so far meant more than just his promotion to Yon Dan. He also received more knowledge that he could bring back to his own students.

Leake no longer charges for training. He is happy to know that he has filled a role as an instructor and opened doors that may have never been opened for his students. His dedication to the art has won him an invitation to train in a rare and extremely complex Okinawan style known as the Matsumura Hakutsuru (White Crane). Leake and two of his Black Belt students have been training in this style for the past year and are now in contact with Shorin-Ryu Martial Artists from all

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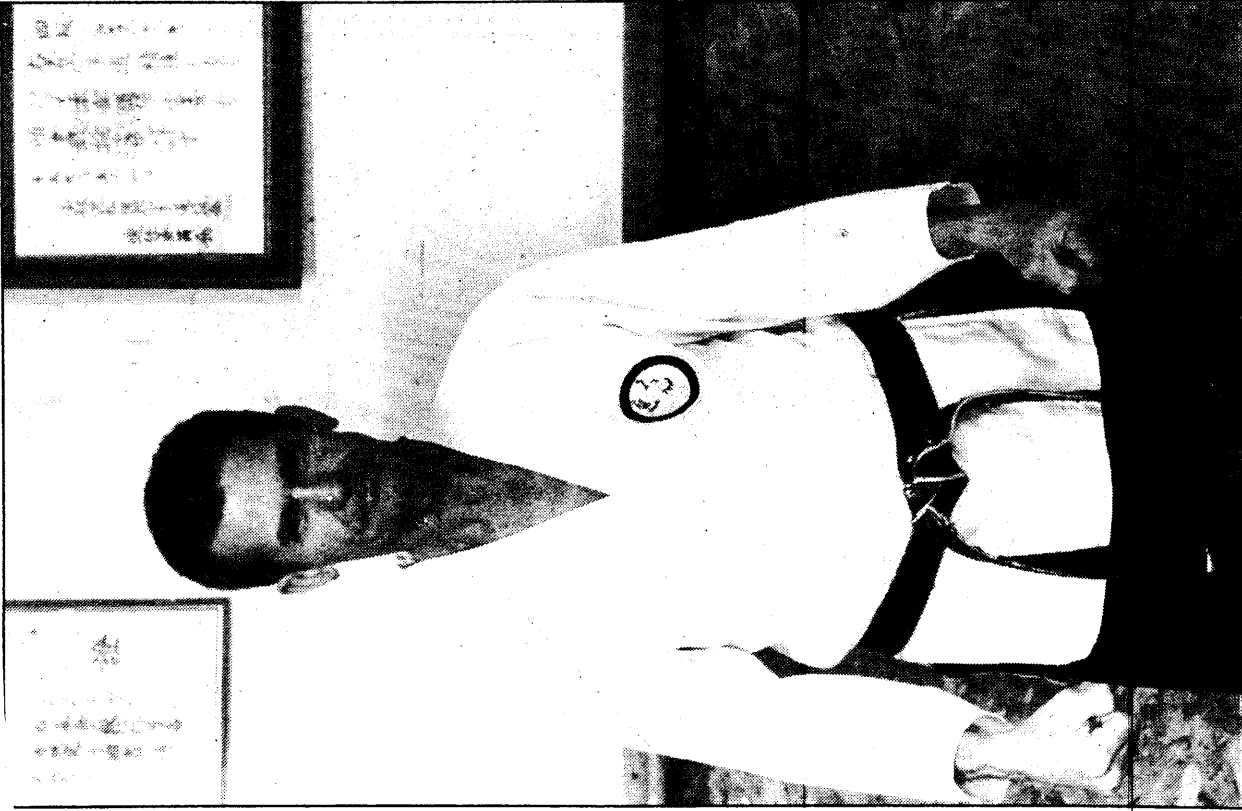

over the United States. His devotion and ground breaking efforts have brought considerable knowledge and opportunity to Lebanon and surrounding areas.

Leake said that in the Martial Arts arena, Lebanon is well-known not only for its Shorin-Ryu, but for its solid training in general.

"What we now have to offer is better than anything we've had before," he said. "We're very clear about the history of our instruction and how it got to us. We can trace our lineage back to Bushi Matsumura (the founder of Shorin-Ryu), we have access to knowledge and Masters that have trained in

Okinawa and we have networking ability with people from all over the country." Certification for rank also comes through Okinawa.

Leake's Martial Arts Studio has hosted a Marion County Country Ham Days demonstration for the past eleven years and is now preparing for this year's festivities. He's now 56 and teaches three classes a week. His agility is still remarkable.

"Ultimately, Karate is an expression of love, love for yourself and for others," he said. "There's nothing mystical about it and anyone can do it. If you want to understand what that means, come see me in my dojo."

HEIR TO VAST ESTATE: Rafe Leake, left yesterday for New York City to testify in a law suit which is docketed for December 6. The case at law involves an amounts said to be not less than six hundred million dollafs.

Over one hundred years ago a man named Leake owned lands now the heart of New York City, upon which 99 year leases were made and costly buildings were erected. This Mr. Leake had two sisters, whose estates he inherited. He was a bachelor and his property at his death went to his heirs.

W.R. Spalding of this city, is an heir to part of this estate. His mother was one of sixty heirs. His great grandfather was one of twelve heirs. The number of heirs now, however reaches into the hundreds.

Lawyers for these heirs say they feel sure that they will win the case, since recently a will was found upon which the title to this valuable property hinges.
