

 "An application to the Court to ascertain and determine who are the legitimate heirs of John Livers late a private in the 14th Regiment of Infantry in the United States service deceased, and to appoint a Guardian to his infant children. The court on hearing the Testimony produced are of opinion and do determine that the said John Livers, left Suzanne, his widow and 4 infant children who are his legitimate heirs at law: The Court do therefore appoint the said Susanna Livers Guardian to said four infants children to wit. Nicholas, Mary, John and James Livers who here present in Court accept the Guardianship and offers James Marsh and William Morgan as her securities who are approved of by the Court and bond ordered accordingly."

My dear Uncle,

With much pleasure I heard from the Rev. Mr. Hickey of your health and of the interest you still feel for me. Indeed I had almost thought I was forgotten by my relations as I had written different letters & no answer to either. I have found an undeviating and sincere friend in the Rev. Mr. Power. I had taught in a school of the Rev. Mr. Varela's, sometime ago but it is now given up. I teach on my own account a small school of young children. I try to live as economically as possible and I thank God I keep out of debt, but I feel very solitary at times for tho I have some sincere friends the idea of having no relatives is so painful. You may judge the delight with which I rec'd the pleasing intelligence that I had relatives yet living who yet considered me as one worthy of their sympathy.

I have my little school at 110 Canal Street but I wish you to direct any letters for me to the care of the Rev. Mr. Power. I beg you will write me a long letter or let me know exactly how you are situated. I should like very much to see you next summer.

I want you to tell me all the particulars of my Aunts. I'm in anxious expectation of seeing you soon or at least hearing from you. I remain as ever, Your affectionate Niece, REBECCA BECKWITH

PREFACE

Starting in 1968 I did extensive Research on the early Elder families of Maryland, Kentucky and Texas. Some of this research was included in the Genealogy of Thomas Hill and Rebecca Miles which I published in 1971. Considerable research has been added to this over the past five years.

Dr. Richard Dyer Mudd, M.D., author of the 2 volume edition of the Mudd Family of the U.S., and resident of Saginaw, Michigan has also collected considerable Elder material.

Maryland Elder Family and Kin is a compilation and collation of my work with Dr. Mudd's, as well as that of other family genealogists who have contributed their material to either of us.

During the writing of this book I've tried to give credit to proper sources. Most of my material as well as Dr. Mudd's comes from primary sources, Church records, wills, land records, county records, family Bibles, etc. Material which I have not researched but which is included will bear the name of the person who contributed the material first.

Although this book is intended to be of the descendants of William Elder (1707-1775) of Frederick Co., Maryland and his 12 children, I have included the background for William and his two wives which I have researched as well as that for other Elder spouses that has been researched or submitted.

The Elder family could continue to have years of research and be able to fill several volumes. For the errors, omissions and limited research on some lines I ask to be forgiven. I hope my compilation will inspire other family members to complete their lines.

My pleasure comes from sharing my hobby with you the descendants and readers.

By 1766 Guy Elder (4) had received part of Arnold's Delight from his father, William Elder (1). According to Frederick Co. Land Records N, 59, dated April 12, 1770, Guy also purchased Fountain Low from Jacob Christe for ninety pounds of current money.

RICHARD ELDER (5) was the fourth son of William and Ann Wheeler Elder. He was born in 1734 and died in Emmitsburg, Md. 5/16/1790. Richard married Phoebe Deloyzier. His will (GM #2, folio 346) reads as follows:
