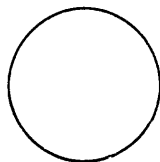

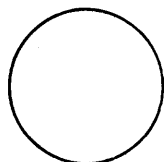

Again Brenda I am sending you some information, I have not found it all ....yet!

### **ST. MARY'S**

St. Mary's is a small community about 6 miles southwest of Lebanon. Like Holy Cross, Nerinx and other Catholic communities in our area it has been a part of the early development of our county. The Catholic church there is St. Charles and there is a cemetery nearby. St. Charles had a fire in the late 1800's (I think) and not all but a number of their records were destroyed, mainly marriage records. The enclosure entitled: **THE CENTENARY OF CATHOLICITY IN KENTUCKY** (heck of a title huh?) by Hon. Ben J. Webb gives an early description of the community and the establishment of St. Mary's College. In the late 1960's the priests sold the property to a group of people from California who established a communal type living arrangement for its members. The local people, county wide, did not receive this "new" group and their real or implied living arrangements and we, in general, Catholic and Protestant alike mourned the loss of the college. About 10 years ago the commune sold the property to a group of men who established it as a minimum security prison for profit. In other words, it is not ran by the state but by private corporation. My mother is the head nurse there now. Many persons were born in St. Mary's community, but don't think to many if any where born at the college. It was an all men's school.

### **FAIRLY FARM**

I am not familiar with any farm in this area by that name. There is a Fairfield community in Nelson County that has a Catholic church, St. Michael's. Also there is in the western part of the state is a community known as Fancy Farm. I have taken the liberty of sending information on it. A number of Catholic families from here went to Henderson, Daviess, Union and Graves counties in the west. Fancy Farm has quite a political history. It hosts an annual picnic that provides political candidates an opportunity to make speeches and shake hands with voters. It draws thousands of people from all over the state.

### **MARION COUNTY MARRIAGES**

These are marriages that were performed in this county from 1834 to 1872 that we have a record of. The second page tells which are recorded in the Marion County Courthouse and which were located in records at the Catholic churches.

### **SAMUEL LUCKETT**

It appears that Lloyd Luckett did have a brother named Henry and they were the sons of Henry



Luckett who was the son of Samuel Luckett. As for proof on this information I have none, I found this information in the family files in Frankfort at the Historical Society. Perhaps if you could locate the book, "THE LUCKETTS OF PORTOBACCO" the proof may be recorded in it. The book was not at the historical society. Information on it may be available in Maryland.

### **CENSUSES MARION COUNTY KENTUCKY**

1850, 1860 - These pages have the George Luckett's family on them.

1880 - This has Amanda Spalding Luckett and children living in the home with I assume her parents.

1910 and 1920 - I copied the information only on Joseph and Eugenia Luckett's family. The children who were born after 1911, I would be able to get a copy (if on file) from the local health department of their birth certificate. The certificates there are \$3.00 each but are not the official ones. You can get an official birth certificate from the Office of Vital Statistics, 275 E. Main Street, Cabinet for Human Resources, Frankfort, Kentucky, 40601 for \$10 each. The certificates from the local health department contain the same information: name of parents their ages, number of births, number of living children as the official record. The only difference is you get a xerox copy from the health department and the Vital statistics folks put it on official paper and notarize it as a true copy. To get to the baptismal records may take some doing and I don't know if I can accomplish this. I am protestant and it is very difficult for anyone who is not <sup>Catholic and</sup> a direct relative to get access to the Holy Name of Mary church records in Calvary. But I will see.

### **HOLY NAME OF MARY CATHOLIC CHURCH - CALVARY KENTUCKY**

Enclosed is a listing of Lucketts buried in this cemetery. This listing was done around 1970 so a lot of newer burials are not recorded here. Evidently there are four infants buried there but have no names or dates. William Eugene is a possibility but again just a birth date and no death date. In looking over it I did not see any infant deaths that would have fit the time frame for Joseph B. and Eugenia's children. From everything that I have found thus far, they were members of this parish.

Enumerations were taken in the thirteen original states: Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Connecticut, Rhode Island, New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Delaware, Maryland, Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Georgia. Enumerations were also taken of Vermont which became a state in 1791, Maine which was part of Massachusetts, Kentucky which was a part of Virginia, and the present states of Alabama and Mississippi which were parts of Georgia. There was also a census of the present state of Tennessee which was a part of North Carolina in 1790 but was organized as the Southwest Territory soon thereafter.

Unfortunately, some of the early census schedules had been lost or could not be found by the Census Bureau in 1907 when the Director of the Census directed their publication. Those missing are for the states of Delaware, Georgia, Kentucky, New Jersey, Tennessee (Southwest Territory), and Virginia. They were believed to have been destroyed when the British burned the Capitol at Washington during the War of 1812. This has been discounted because most of the schedules likely remained in the hands of the U.S. District Courts until the resolution of March 28, 1830.

For the states for which the schedules are missing the government attempted to fill in with substitutions from state and county tax lists.

The 1850 census is the first to list the names of the wife, children, and other persons in each household. Their age, occupation, value of property is listed. This census reveals whether adults could read or write, who had married within the year, children attending school, and those with physical impairments, such as: blind, deaf or idiotic. As the majority of the adults could not read or write, many of the names are spelled phonetically. In many cases the vowels are missing. The same family name has a number of variations, such as: Payton, Peyton, and Pyton.

Appreciation is expressed to Bertha Wesley who assisted in checking microfilm information, and to the personnel of the Casey County Public Library for assistance and cooperation in many ways.

It is hoped that this publication will encourage the research of ancestors who lived in Casey County, Kentucky in 1850.
