worked as a house carpenter. It is believed that he laid the first tongue-and-grove floor ever put down in Lexington. Locating in Washington County, KY, he married Sarah, daughter of Harry Boone, and purchased a track of land on Hardin's Creek known as the Rice Survey and erected the first copper-still ever operated in Washington County. Both paternal and maternal families were Catholic.

The only person who ever mentioned (that our generation remembers) Anthony was Aunt Mary Jo who told Marietta Washburn Urban when she was a young girl. She said he was a window washer of tall buildings and lost his footing falling to his death. Aunt Jo only mentioned it that one time. Mary said she never talked about her family background.
